Summary

TNT Rescue Systems Inc. has offered to donate a Honda Ex Demo Extrication Tool Set to Riverside County Fire Department. The equipment will be used in auto extrication classes hosted at Ben Clark Training Center. The tools come with a lifetime warranty which covers any failure or broken parts. The estimated value of this set is \$14,000. The annual maintenance cost is estimated at \$500.

An Extrication Tool Set is powered by a hydraulic pump. It is a tool used by emergency rescue personnel to assist vehicle extrication of crash victims, as well as other rescues from small spaces. These tools include cutters, spreaders, and rams.

The transfer is beneficial for the Riverside County Fire Department as well as the surrounding Cities and Unincorporated areas. The tool will be used at Ben Clark Training Center (BCTC) for training purposes.
