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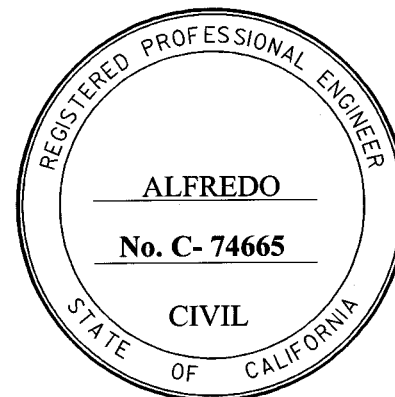

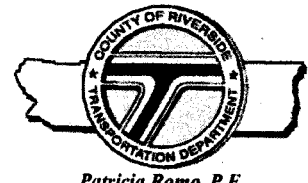

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Item 2: Revised Proposal. Refer to bid item 93 on revised bid proposal issued by addendum 1 as an Attachment A. Following correction has been made to bid item 93.

Bid Item 93; MISCELLANEOUS GRADING (~~AS DIRECTED~~)

The bidders are advised to cross out "As Directed" in item description as shown above.

Item #3: Section 12-3.32, Portable Changeable Message Signs

Refer to Section **Portable Changeable Message Signs** on page 17 of the Bid Book. The second paragraph has been revised as follow and made part thereof.

Contractor shall start displaying minimum of two (one in each direction of traffic) PCMS boards two weeks prior to start of construction activities at each project location and remain throughout the construction duration.

Item #4: Section 12-5.01, Traffic Control System/Public Convenience/Public Safety

Refer to Section **12-5.01, Traffic Control System/Public Convenience/Public Safety**, on page 19 of the Bid Book. The following revision to MUTCD edition has been made and the bidders/Contractors are advised to update the reference as noted below:

The applicable edition of Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices (MUTCD) shall be 2014 edition.

Item #5: Section 73-1.02B, Detectable Warning Surfaces

Refer to Section **73-1.02B, Detectable Warning Surfaces** on page 64 of the Bid Book. This section has been removed and replaced with the following Special Provisions and made part thereof.

DETECTABLE WARNING SURFACES (TRUNCATED DOME PANELS)

This work includes installing detectable warning surfaces on the curb ramps or on the areas as shown and specified on the plans, in conformance with section 73-1.02B, section 73-3 and section 73-3.01D(2) of Standard Specifications, Standard Plans, these Special Provisions, and as directed by the Engineer.

The curb ramp detectable warning surface will be a rigid polymer composite/fiberglass panel set into wet concrete for new ramp.

The color of the detectable warning surfaces will be yellow complying with Federal Standard 595B, Color No. 33538.

The manufacturer must provide a written 5-year warranty for detectable warning surface, guaranteeing replacement when there is defect in the dome shape, color fastness, sound-

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on-cane acoustic quality, resilience, or attachment. The warranty period will begin upon acceptance of the contract.

Installation of curb ramp detectable warning surface must comply with the manufacturer's recommendations.

Full compensation for Detectable Warning Surfaces (Truncated Dome Panels) shall be considered as included in the contract unit prices paid for the Minor Concrete-Curb Ramp bid item, and shall include full compensation for furnishing all labor, materials, tools, equipment and incidentals for doing all work involved in constructing detectable warning surface, complete in place, as shown and specified on the plans, as specified in these Special Provisions, and as directed by the Engineer, and no separate payment will be made therefor.


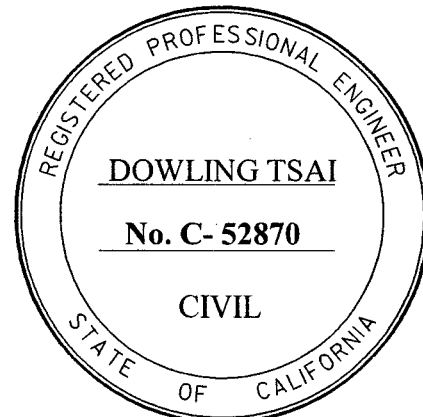

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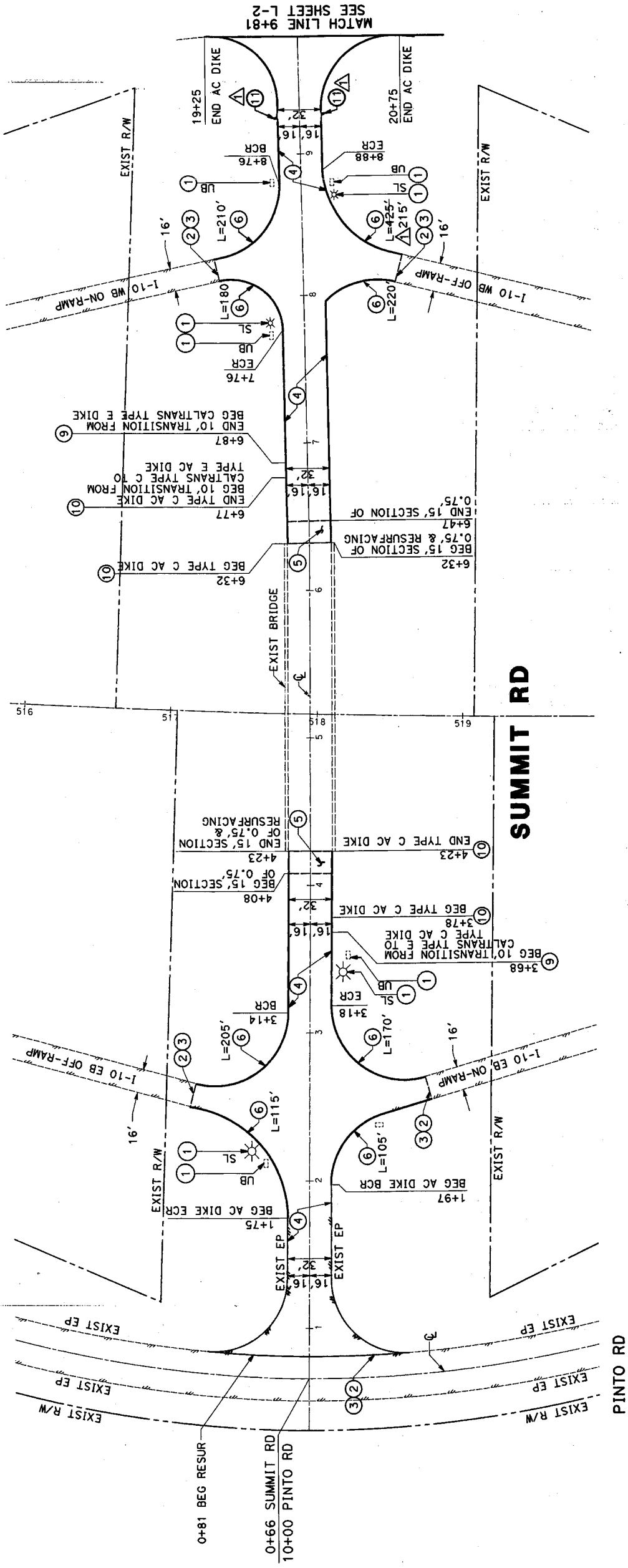

2. County has the right to reject any or all Bids and to waive any irregularities or informalities contained in a Bid.
3. To execute the Contract and deliver the Performance Bond, Payment Bond and Insurance Certificate with endorsements, that comply with the requirements set forth in the Instruction to Bidders and General Conditions within ten (10) business days of the date of the Notice of Acceptance of Bid and Intent to Award as issued by the County.
4. That the contract shall be awarded upon a resolution or minute order to that effect duly adopted by the governing body of County; and that execution of the Contract shall constitute a written memorial thereof.
5. To submit to the County such information as County may require determining whether a particular Bid is the lowest responsible bid submitted.
6. That the accompanying Bid Bond, certified check or cashier's check is in an amount not less than 10% of the total bid submitted and constitutes a guarantee that if awarded the contract, Contractor will execute the Contract and deliver the required bonds within ten (10) business days after notice of award. If Contractor fails to execute and deliver said documents, the bond or check is to be charged with the costs of the resultant damages to the County, including but not limited to: publication costs, the difference in money between the amount bid and the amount in excess of the bid which it costs County to do or cause to be done for the work involved, lease and rental costs, additional salaries and overhead, increased interest and costs of funding the project, attorney expense, additional engineering and architectural expense and cost of maintaining or constructing alternate facilities occasioned by the failure to execute and deliver said documents.
