Dear Riverside County Board of Supervisors:

Below is a tabulation of the information that was provided to Riverside County Board of Supervisors by Dean Stamp a representative of the Mountain View Civic Association during the supervisors board meeting on Tuesday March 13, 2018. This letter documents, for the record, the numbers that were presented. This survey was undertaken as a result of the proposed amendment application by OXBOW in 2017 to change the General Plan for the golf course.

The MVCA represents hundreds of residents living in the area near, though not all directly adjacent to the former golf course; this survey represents a subset of only those who are directly adjacent to the abandoned golf course.

As stated in the meeting, these residents were presented with a survey and asked to sign the survey if they were opposed to rezoning the golf course land.

The results of the survey clearly indicate the position of these residents. These results are summarized in the following table:

As you can see from the above table, an overall 90.8% of the households contacted are opposed to rezoning the former golf course. Hard copies of the signed surveys can be provided to the Riverside Board of Supervisors upon request.

Please note that MVCA community members that live in the same area nut not directly adjacent to the abandoned golf courses are equally opposed to any rezoning and have expressed the same opposition to rezoning the golf course land.

We are requesting that the Riverside County Board of Supervisors use this information to support a vote against General Plan Amendment #1174 (if and when it comes to a vote) which would change the golf course land use from Open Space Recreational to Community Development

The above results are from constituents residing next to the former golf course. If you have been provided any information or data that disputes the conclusions provided here the MVCA would appreciate being given access to that data.

The MVCA community is willing to meet with the Riverside Board of Supervisors to discuss this item at the boards' earliest convenience.
