BACKGROUND:

Summary

In accordance with the County's Citizen Participation Plan and 24 CFR Section 91.105(e), a public hearing needs to be conducted to obtain citizen's views on community development needs and proposed uses of Community Planning and Development (CPD) funding in the One-Year Action Plan.

Pursuant to the County's Citizen Participation Plan and 24 CFR Section 91.105, the Economic Development Agency published the required public notices notifying the public of the comment period for the proposed 2018-2019 One-Year Action Plan of the 2014-2019 Five-Year Consolidated Plan and the public hearing.

At a later date, staff will submit the final 2018-2019 One-Year Action Plan of the 2014-2019 Five year Consolidated Plan to the Board of Supervisors for review and adoption. The One-Year Action Plan will identify the specific activities selected for Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), Home Investment Partnership Program (HOME), and Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG) funding. Upon completion of the citizen participation process, the review and consideration of comments, and the review and adoption by the Board of Supervisors, the final 2018-2019 One-Year Action Plan of the 2014-2019 Five Year Consolidated Plan will be forwarded to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) for review and approval. The date for presentation of the final 2018-2019 One-Year Action Plan to the Board of Supervisors will be determined once the Federal FY 2018 appropriations have been approved by Congress.

The proposed activities under the 2018-2019 HUD-funded Community Planning and Development (CPD) programs are attached.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

It is anticipated that the County's 2018-2019 CPD allocation will total \$9,267,556 for the CDBG, HOME, and ESG programs.

Additional Fiscal Information

No impact on the County's General Fund and no budget adjustment is required.
