BACKGROUND:

Summary

As a requirement of the Federally Qualified Health Center ("FQHC") designation, the County must have a Community Health Centers Board which is authorized by County Ordinance. There are thirteen (13) to twenty-five (25) positions on the Board which a majority must be users of services at the Community Family Care Centers. Board members must also be broadly representative of the characteristics of the population served. The Community Health Centers Board has reviewed and accepted the reappointment of Barry Corindia.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

An active Community Health Centers Board is an important element in maintaining high quality health care at the County's FQHC outpatient clinics.
