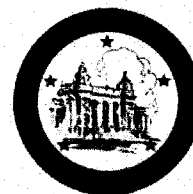



BACKGROUND:

Summary

The Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) provides for the reconstruction of the Limonite Avenue at Interstate-15 (I-15) Interchange Improvement Project in the Cities of Eastvale and Jurupa Valley as show on the attached vicinity map.

The I-15/Limonite Avenue Interchange Project consists of improving the existing interchange to provide six lanes on Limonite Avenue through the interchange area, reconstructing the overcrossing bridge to provide six through lanes and right turn lanes to the new on-ramps, construction of new northbound and southbound loop on-ramps, reconstruction and widening of the northbound and southbound off-ramps and addition of freeway auxiliary lanes to improve traffic operations for existing and future traffic demand (Project).

On January 29, 2013 (Agenda Item 3-47), the County of Riverside (County) and the cities of Eastvale and Jurupa Valley (Cities) entered into a Cooperative Agreement for the development of the Environmental, Design and Right-of-Way acquisition phases of the interchange Project.

On April 28, 2017, the Governor approved Senate Bill 132 (SB-132) which added an appropriation to the Budget Act of 2016 which included provisions for providing \$48,000,000 in State funding to reconstruct the existing I-15/Limonite Avenue Interchange.

On October 17, 2017, Agenda Item 3.24, the Board approved an amendment to the agreement between the County and the Cities that added the Riverside County Transportation Commission

(RCTC) as a party to the agreement for the administration of SB-132 Funds and designated the County as the lead agency for construction of the Project. On the same Agenda (Item 3.25), the Board approved the Construction Cooperative Agreement between the County of Riverside and Caltrans to identify the roles and responsibilities for the construction phase of the project. The project is now ready to advertise for bids for the construction of the project.

The bid documents include the following bid schedules of work:

Base Bid: Interchange Improvements
Alternate Bid Sch. A: Waterline Extension (CDA/JCSD)
Alternate Bid Sch. B: Landscape work
Alternate Bid Sch. C: Waterline on overscrossing (JCSD)
Alternate Bid Sch. D: Waterline on overscrossing (CDA)

The County will select the contractor based upon the lowest responsive and responsible bid of the sum of all bid schedules. Jurupa Community Services District (JCSD) and Chino Basin Desalter Authority (CDA) will reimburse the construction cost for their respective alternate bid schedules if selected for award.

Landscaping work within the City of Jurupa Valley is an alternative bid and will be selected for award if the bids are favorable and fall within the funding plan for the project.

The submitted plans and specifications have been approved as to form by County Counsel.

Environmental Findings

On June 21, 2016, Agenda Item 3.71, the Board of Supervisors as the Responsible Agency adopted the Final Initial Study and Mitigation Negative Declaration and adopted the Mitigation Monitoring and Reporting Program (MMRP) based on the findings in the Initial Study and the conclusion that the project would not have a significant effect on the environment. The County of Riverside Transportation Department filed a CEQA Notice of Determination with the Riverside County Clerk's Office on June 22, 2016; this posting was terminated on July 29, 2016.

Furthermore, pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) and the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA), Caltrans, as the Lead Agency, approved a Mitigated Negative Declaration (MND) on March 3, 2016 and made a Categorical Exclusion (CE) determination on March 3, 2016, such that the State has determined that project is a CE under 23 USC 327 based on the examination of the Project proposal and supporting information. On February 26, 2018, Caltrans issued the NEPA/CEQA Revalidation. Therefore, advertisement of the Project is an implementing action in furtherance of the Interchange Improvement Project, and nothing further is required because all potentially significant effects have been adequately addressed in the CEQA IS/MND and the NEPA CE.

Impact on Citizens and Businesses

The proposed Limonite Avenue at I-15 Interchange Improvement Project will reduce traffic congestion and improve overall traffic flow within the interchange and on the I-15 corridor for the current and future residents and businesses within the project region. The interchange will remain open for the duration of the construction phase with the exception of limited short term closures, typically during night hours.

Construction is scheduled to begin in mid-2018 and will take approximately 18 months to complete.

SUPPLEMENTAL:

Additional Fiscal Information

The construction contract is estimated to cost approximately \$47,880,950.

On April 6, 2017, the California Senate approved Senate Bill Number 132 which added appropriation to the budget bill to provide \$427,172,000 for five major transportation projects. SB-132 includes provisions for providing funding in the amount of \$48 Million for the construction on the I-15/Limonite Avenue Interchange project. SB-132 funds for the project will be distributed through the RCTC.



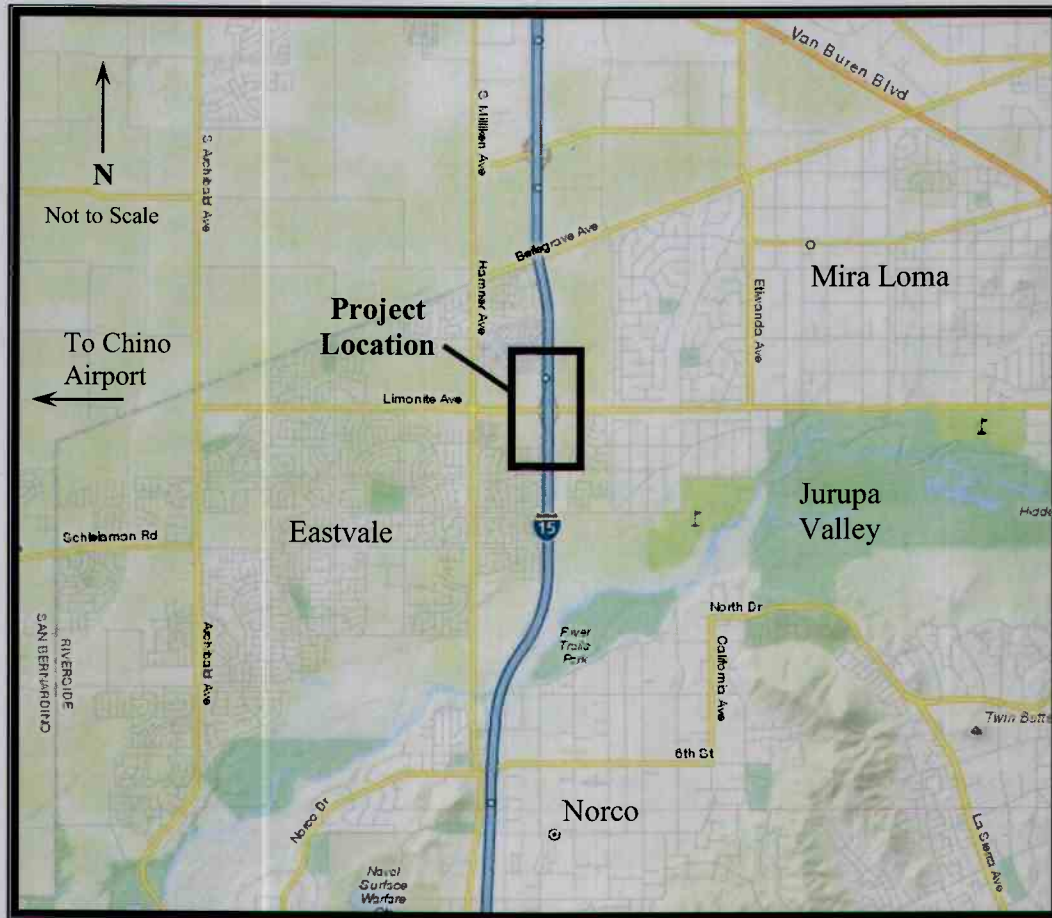

DESCRIPTION AND LOCATION: The County of Riverside (County) proposes to approve the plans and specifications and advertise for the construction bid of the Interstate 15 (I-15)/ Limonite Avenue Interchange Improvement Project (the Project) located in the Cities of Eastvale and City of Jurupa Valley.

The Project is a proposed modification of the existing interchange. Approval of the plans, specifications and authorization to advertise for bid of construction is necessary in order to construct the Interchange improvements which were cleared per the CEQA Mitigated Negative Declaration (MND)/ Initial Study (IS) and NEPA Categorical Exclusion (CE) prepared by Caltrans for the Project. On June 21, 2016 per Agenda Item 3.71, the Riverside County Board of Supervisors as the Responsible Agency adopted the Final Initial Study (IS)/Mitigation Negative Declaration (MND) and adopted the Mitigation Monitoring and Reporting Program (MMRP) based on the findings that the project would not have a significant effect on the environment. The County of Riverside Transportation Department filed a CEQA Notice of Determination with the Riverside County Clerk's Office on June 22, 2016; this posting was terminated on July 29, 2016. Pursuant CEQA and NEPA, Caltrans as the Lead Agency approved the CEQA MND on March 3, 2016 and made a NEPA Categorical Exclusion (CE) determination on March 3, 2016 per 23 USC 327. On February 2/26/2018, Caltrans issued the NEPA/CEQA Revalidation. Therefore, advertisement of the Project is an implementing action in furtherance of the Interchange Project, and nothing further is required because all potentially significant effects have been adequately addressed in the CEQA IS/MND and the NEPA CE. The documents may be examined, along with the administrative record, at the Transportation Department, 3525 14th Street, Riverside, CA, 92501.

2. A Mitigated Negative Declaration was prepared for this Project pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.

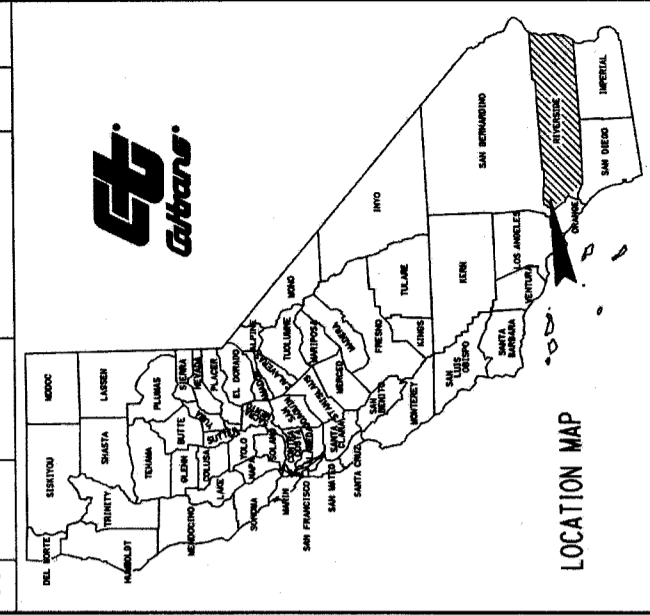

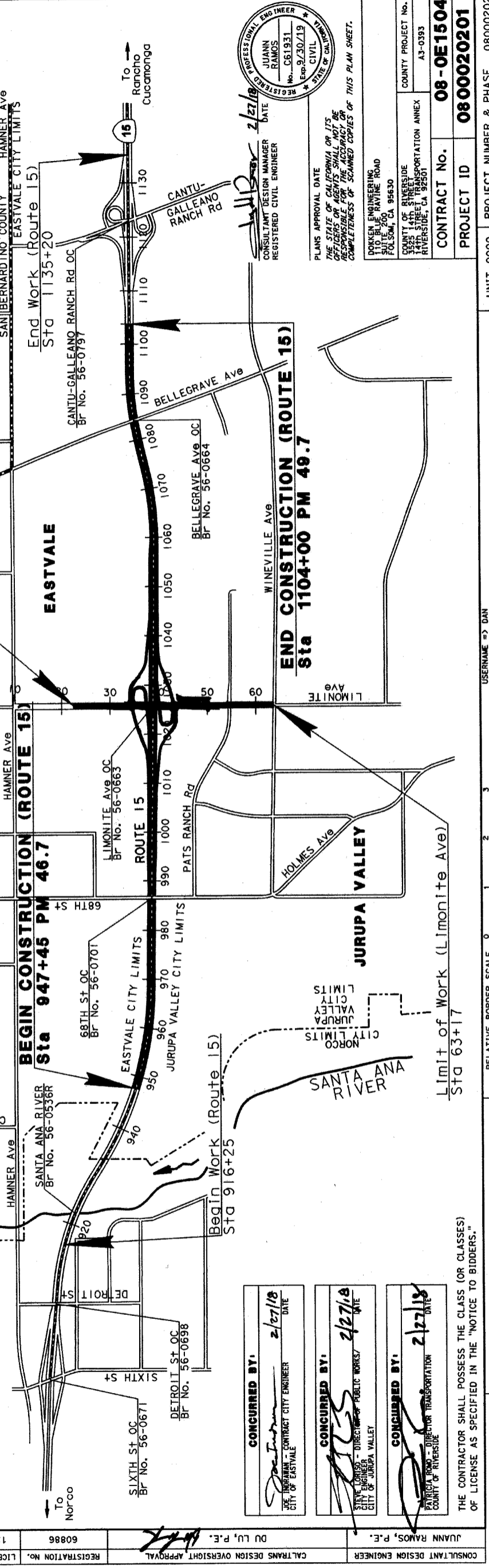

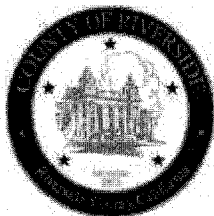
