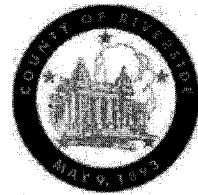





**BACKGROUND:** Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

1. Diamond Valley Arts Council - \$1,000 the funding will be used for the Art for Youth Competition designed to highlight the artistic talents of high school youth.
2. Riverside County Sheriff's Dept. - \$500 the funding will be utilized for the annual awards ceremony, which recognizes volunteers, outside law enforcement agencies and citizens that serve Riverside County.
3. Voices / Joey's Pals - \$1,000 the funding will be college scholarships for students in the Homeland area.
