

BACKGROUND: Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

1. The Boys & Girls Club of Palm Springs provides service to over 1,200 youth ages 5 to 18 in a variety of afterschool, Saturday and school vacation programs. Boys & Girls Club of America has rolled out a new technology program called My Futures. This programs offers badges and certificates for each level of learning and the students are able to work on this at the club and on their own time at home. The CID funds will be utilized to purchase ten Chromebooks for the youth to use for this program, also to purchase food to be used as an incentive at the end of the various modules.
2. Galilee Center hosted their annual Angels Dinner on March 2, 2018. This event helps raise funds to support services provided by the Galilee Center. CID funds will be utilized towards the cost of the food for the event.
