

BACKGROUND:

Summary

The County of Riverside (County) is proposing to slurry seal approximately 1.4 miles of Brookside Avenue as one of the roads in the Slurry Seal Projects for 4th and 5th Districts. A portion of Brookside Avenue is within the City of Beaumont (City) jurisdiction. The City has requested that this segment of Brookside Avenue be included in the County's Slurry Seal Project.

This Service Agreement between the County and the City outlines each agency's responsibilities for the completion of the Slurry Seal Improvements and obligates the City to fund 100% of the slurry seal improvements within the jurisdictional boundaries of the City.

The City will deposit \$115,380 prior to the start of the construction contract. The County is providing services and has no obligation to fund any portion of this project within the City's jurisdiction.

By Minute Order 3.32 of December 5, 2017, the Board of Supervisors authorized the Clerk of the Board to advertise for bid the Slurry Seal Project at various locations in the 4th and 5th Supervisorial Districts. Bids were opened on January 17, 2018 and the contract award is a companion item on this same board agenda.

This Service Agreement was approved by the Beaumont City Council on February 20, 2018.

County Counsel has approved the agreement as to legal form.

Project Number: C8-0009 (District 4), C8-0010 (District 5)

Impact on Residents and Businesses

The proposed improvements will improve safety and enhance operational efficiency for traffic on Brookside Avenue. The slurry seal treatment will also preserve and extend the life of the road thereby reducing the need for resurfacing, which is ten times more costly.



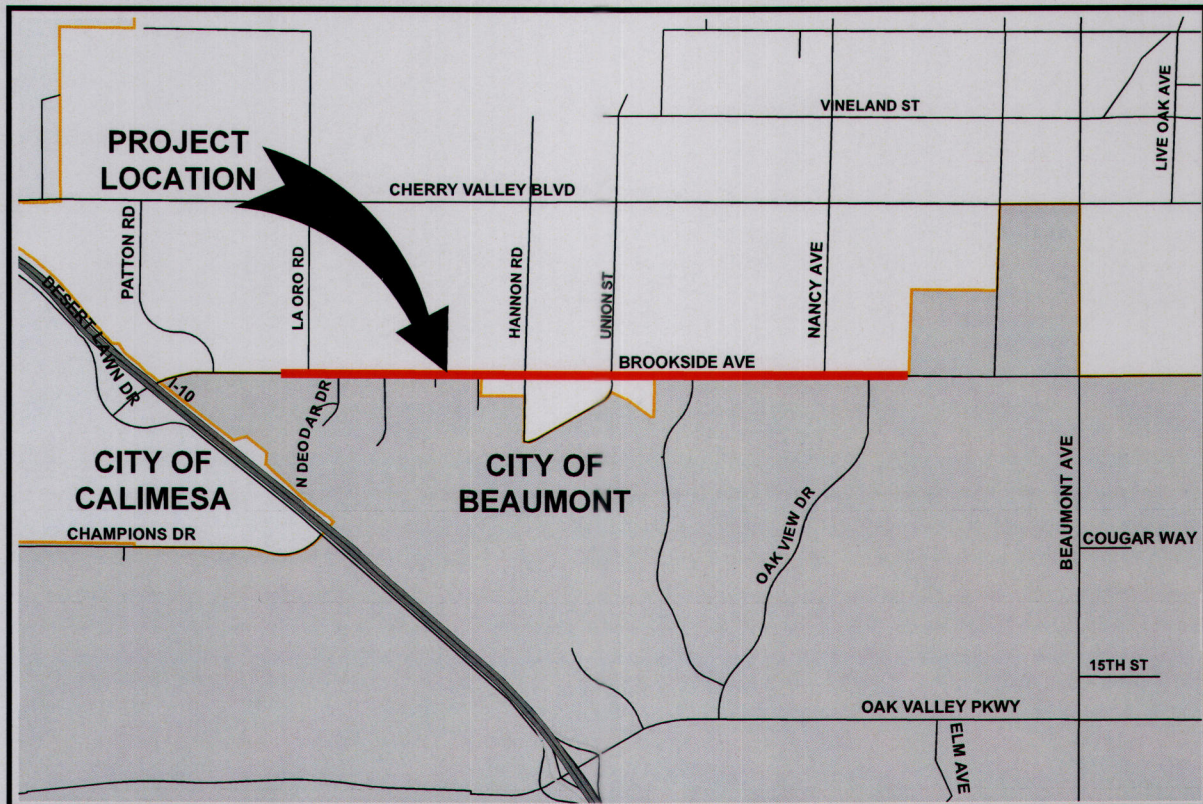
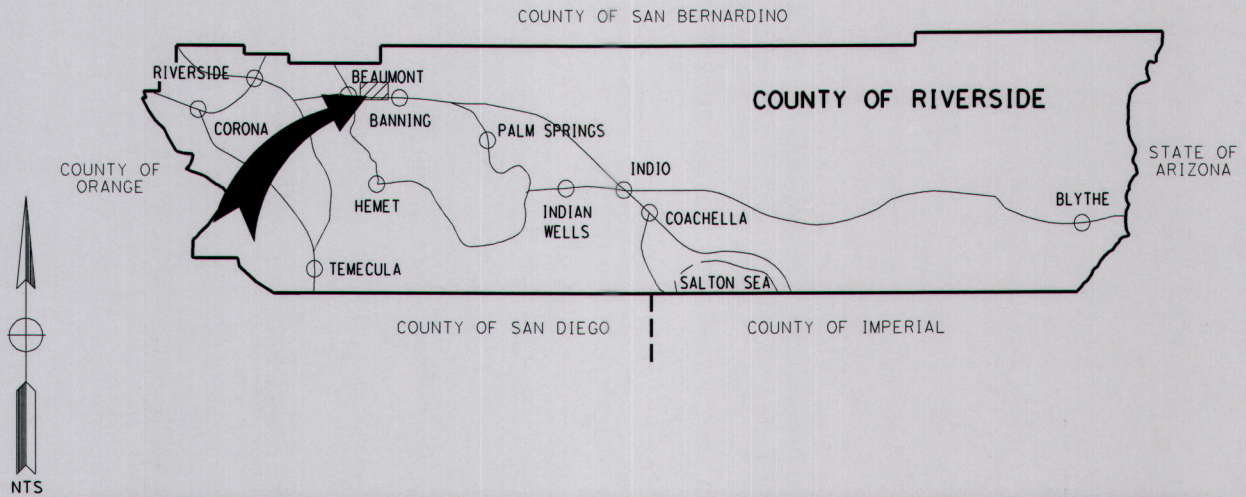

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SERVICE AGREEMENT BY AND BETWEEN

COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE

AND

CITY OF BEAUMONT

FOR

BROOKSIDE AVENUE SLURRY SEAL IMPROVEMENTS

This Agreement is entered into this 27th day of March, 2018, by and between the County of Riverside, (hereinafter "COUNTY"), and the City of Beaumont, (hereinafter "CITY") for Slurry Seal Improvements located within the jurisdictional boundaries of CITY. The COUNTY and CITY are sometimes hereinafter referred to individually as the "PARTY" and collectively as the "PARTIES".

RECITALS

- A. COUNTY is proposing to slurry seal the existing asphalt surface on Brookside Avenue, from 1390 feet west of Deodar Drive to 4,588 feet East of Union Street, approximately 7,467 linear feet, in the Chery Valley area of Riverside County.
- B. The Slurry Seal Improvements for Brookside Avenue consists of applying a slurry seal (Type 2), which is a mixture of asphalt emulsion, aggregate (sand to pea gravel size aggregate), water and chemical additives. Curb ramps will also be upgraded to conform to ADA Standards.
- C. The work includes traffic control, rout and seal random cracks, replacement of any pavement marking, including crosswalks, striping and raised pavement markers.
- D. The Brookside Avenue Slurry Seal improvements described above, within the jurisdictional boundaries of the COUNTY are hereinafter referred to collectively as "COUNTY PROJECT".
- E. A portion of Brookside Avenue, located directly adjacent to the COUNTY PROJECT, specifically the southerly side of Brookside Avenue from 1390 feet west of Deodar Drive to 4,588 feet east of Union Street is within the jurisdictional boundaries of CITY.
- F. Within the CITY portion of Brookside Avenue, the asphalt pavement is approximately 7,467 feet in length and 20 feet wide. The total asphalt surface area of the CITY portion is approx. 16,077 square yards.
- G. The CITY will benefit from the cost savings associated with a larger improvement project. The CITY requests the Brookside Avenue Slurry Seal improvements, as described above, be provided for the area

1 within the jurisdictional boundaries of CITY. These improvements for this area are hereinafter referred to
2 collectively as "CITY PROJECT". The location of the CITY PROJECT is shown in Exhibit "A".

3 H. The CITY desires to allow the COUNTY to construct the CITY PROJECT, together with the COUNTY
4 PROJECT since COUNTY has extensive experience in the development and implementation of similar
5 types of projects.

6 I. COUNTY will therefore provide the administrative, technical, managerial, and support services necessary
7 for the implementation of the CITY PROJECT as part of the COUNTY PROJECT.

8 J. COUNTY and CITY desire to define herein the terms and conditions under which said CITY PROJECT is
9 to be administered, engineered, coordinated, and constructed.

10 **AGREEMENT**

11 NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises contained herein, the parties hereto agree as follows:

12 **SECTION 1 • COUNTY AGREES:**

- 13 1. To act as the lead agency on behalf of the CITY for the overall implementation of the CITY PROJECT. The
14 COUNTY is providing services on a reimbursable basis and has no obligation to fund any portion of the
15 CITY PROJECT. Nothing in this Agreement is intended to commit the COUNTY to provide replacement
16 funding for or to continue with the CITY PROJECT, if funds are not available.
- 17 2. COUNTY has prepared detailed Plans, Specifications & Estimate (PS&E) documents for the COUNTY
18 PROJECT which can be amended to include the CITY PROJECT and are available to CITY for review and
19 approval. Final plans for improvements are prepared to COUNTY standards, and signed by a Civil Engineer
20 registered in the State of California. Deviations from standards shall be coordinated with and approved by
21 CITY. COUNTY shall not begin construction within CITY until CITY has approved the CITY PROJECT
22 portion of the PS&E documents.
- 23 3. To act as the Lead Agency under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) for the COUNTY
24 PROJECT. The CITY will prepare and approve CEQA clearance for the CITY PROJECT.
- 25 4. To direct COUNTY's contractor to identify any existing surface utility facilities within the limits of the CITY
26 PROJECT and to protect the facilities as detailed in the Special Provisions of the PS&E.
- 27 5. To direct COUNTY's contractor to make written application to CITY for an encroachment permit authorizing
28 entry into CITY right of way for the purposes of constructing COUNTY PROJECT and CITY PROJECT.
- 29 6. To advertise, award and administer a public works contract for the construction of the COUNTY PROJECT

- 1 and the CITY PROJECT in accordance with all applicable federal, state or local statutes, ordinances,
2 orders, governmental requirements, laws or regulations, including but not limited to the local agency public
3 construction codes, California Labor Code, and California Public Contract Code, and in accordance with
4 the encroachment permits issued by CITY.
- 5 7. To furnish a representative to perform the function of Resident Engineer during construction of CITY
6 PROJECT.
- 7 8. To furnish qualified support staff to assist the Resident Engineer in, but not limited to, construction surveys,
8 soils and compaction tests, measurement and computation of quantities, testing of construction materials,
9 checking submittals, preparation of estimates and reports, preparation of as-built drawings, and other
10 inspection and staff services necessary to assure that the construction is performed in accordance with the
11 PS&E documents.
- 12 9. To construct the CITY PROJECT in accordance with approved PS&E documents.
- 13 10. To submit any contract change order that causes the construction contract to exceed 10% of the contract
14 bid amount for CITY PROJECT improvements to CITY for review and approval prior to final authorization
15 by COUNTY. If any contract change order causes the construction contract to change by less than 10% of
16 the bid amount for CITY PROJECT, COUNTY is authorized by CITY approval of this Agreement to move
17 forward with such change.
- 18 11. To provide material testing and quality control conforming to Caltrans Standard Testing Methods and have
19 the testing performed by certified material tester.
- 20 12. To furnish CITY with a complete set of full-sized film positive reproducible as-built plans and all contract
21 records, including survey documents, within ninety (90) days following the completion and acceptance of
22 the PROJECT construction contract. Electronic copies of completed plans are available if CITY desires. If
23 electronic copies are provided, they will be provided on CD-R media.
- 24 13. To furnish CITY a final reconciliation of project expenses within ninety (90) days following the completion
25 of each Task (as shown on Exhibit "B") and/or the completion and acceptance of the COUNTY PROJECT
26 and CITY PROJECT construction contract. If final costs associated with the CITY PROJECT are in excess
27 of the deposit provided in Section 2, COUNTY shall include a final bill with the financial reconciliation. If
28 final costs associated with the CITY PROJECT are less than the deposit provided in Section 2, COUNTY
29 shall include a reimbursement for the difference with the financial reconciliation.

SECTION 2 • CITY AGREES:

1. To fund one hundred percent (100%) of the cost of the CITY PROJECT, as shown in Exhibit "B". CITY agrees that should unforeseen circumstances arise which result in an increase of any costs over those shown in Exhibit "B", CITY will in good faith amend this Agreement to include any such costs under this Agreement.
2. To deposit with COUNTY, prior to COUNTY start of work and upon written request by COUNTY, one hundred fifteen thousand three hundred eighty dollars and no cents (\$115,380) (the "Deposit"), which represents one hundred percent (100%) of the costs to complete construction, including construction survey, inspection and materials testing for CITY PROJECT, as provided in Exhibit "B".
3. To act as the Lead Agency under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) for the CITY PROJECT.
4. Issue, at no cost to COUNTY or its contractor, upon proper application by COUNTY or COUNTY's contractor, an encroachment permit authorizing entry onto CITY right-of-way to complete construction, including traffic control, construction survey, inspection and materials testing for the COUNTY PROJECT and CITY PROJECT.
5. To provide at no cost to the COUNTY, oversight of the CITY PROJECT, to provide prompt reviews and approvals, as appropriate, of submittals by COUNTY, and to cooperate in timely processing of the CITY PROJECT.
6. To provide at no cost to COUNTY, a representative to coordinate and assist the COUNTY Resident Engineer during the construction of the CITY PROJECT and to verify facilities are constructed as required by this Agreement.

SECTION 3 • IT IS MUTUALLY AGREED AS FOLLOWS:

1. The total cost of CITY PROJECT is estimated to be one hundred fifteen thousand three hundred eighty dollars and no cents (\$115,380) as detailed in Exhibit "B".
2. COUNTY and CITY acknowledge and agree that any funding shortfall for the completion of the CITY PROJECT will be the sole responsibility of CITY. Nothing in this Agreement is intended to commit the COUNTY to funding any portion of CITY PROJECT, or shall be construed as obligating the COUNTY to provide replacement funding for any anticipated funding or to continue with the CITY PROJECT, if funds are no longer available. In the event that adequate funds are not available to move forward or to complete CITY PROJECT, PARTIES agree to meet and confer and collectively work to identify adequate funding for

- 2 3. Construction by COUNTY of improvements referred to herein which lie within CITY rights of way shall not
- 3 be commenced until an Encroachment Permit to COUNTY, or COUNTY's contractor, authorizing such work
- 4 has been issued by CITY.
- 5 4. COUNTY shall not be obligated to commence the CITY PROJECT until after receipt of CITY's deposit as
- 6 required in Section 2, Article (2).
- 7 5. Construction by COUNTY of improvements for CITY PROJECT shall not be commenced until an
- 8 Encroachment Permit to COUNTY, or COUNTY's contractor, authorizing such work has been issued by
- 9 CITY.
- 10 6. COUNTY shall cause COUNTY's contractor to maintain in force, until completion and acceptance of the
- 11 Brookside Avenue Slurry Seal Improvements, a policy of Commercial Liability Insurance, including
- 12 coverage of Bodily Injury Liability and Property Damage Liability, in the amount of \$2,000,000 minimum
- 13 single limit coverage, and a policy of Automobile Liability Insurance in the amount of \$1,000,000 minimum.
- 14 Endorsements to each policy shall be required which name CITY, its officers, agents and employees, as
- 15 additionally insured. COUNTY shall also require COUNTY's contractor to maintain Worker's Compensation
- 16 Insurance. COUNTY shall cause COUNTY's contractor to provide Certificates of Insurance and Additional
- 17 Insured Endorsements which meet the requirements of this section to CITY prior to the start of construction.
- 18 7. Ownership and title to all materials, equipment, and appurtenances installed as part of this Agreement will
- 19 be automatically vested with the jurisdiction in which the improvements reside and no further agreement
- 20 will be necessary to transfer ownership.
- 21 8. CITY shall be responsible for the maintenance of the Improvements provided by CITY PROJECT except
- 22 as specified in this Agreement.
- 23 9. No alteration or variation of the terms of this Agreement shall be valid unless made in writing and signed
- 24 by all parties and no oral understanding or agreement not incorporated herein shall be binding on each
- 25 party hereto.
- 26 10. Neither COUNTY nor any officer or employee thereof shall be responsible for any damage or liability
- 27 occurring by reason of any act or omission of CITY under or in connection with any work, authority or
- 28 jurisdiction delegated to CITY under this Agreement. It is further agreed that pursuant to Government Code
- 29 Section 895.4, CITY shall fully indemnify and hold COUNTY harmless from any liability imposed for injury

1 (as defined by Government Code Section 810.8) occurring by reason of any act or omission of CITY under
2 or in connection with any work, authority or jurisdiction delegated to CITY under this Agreement.

3 11. Neither CITY nor any officer or employee thereof shall be responsible for any damage or liability occurring
4 by reason of any act or omission of COUNTY under or in connection with any work, authority or jurisdiction
5 delegated to COUNTY under this Agreement. It is further agreed that pursuant to Government Code
6 Section 895.4, COUNTY shall fully indemnify and hold CITY harmless from any liability imposed for injury
7 (as defined by Government Code Section 810.8) occurring by reason of any act or omission of COUNTY
8 under or in connection with any work, authority or jurisdiction delegated to COUNTY under this Agreement.

9 12. In the event that CITY defaults in the performance of any of its obligations under this Agreement or
10 materially breaches any of the provisions of this Agreement, the COUNTY shall have the option to terminate
11 this Agreement upon 90 days written notice to CITY.

12 13. CITY and COUNTY shall retain or cause to be retained for audit, all records and accounts relating to
13 Brookside Avenue Slurry Seal improvements for a period of minimum three (3) years from the date of Notice
14 of Completion of the COUNTY PROJECT and CITY PROJECT.

15 14. All notices, demands, invoices, and other communications required or permitted hereunder shall be in
16 writing and delivered to the following addresses or such other address as the PARTIES may designate:

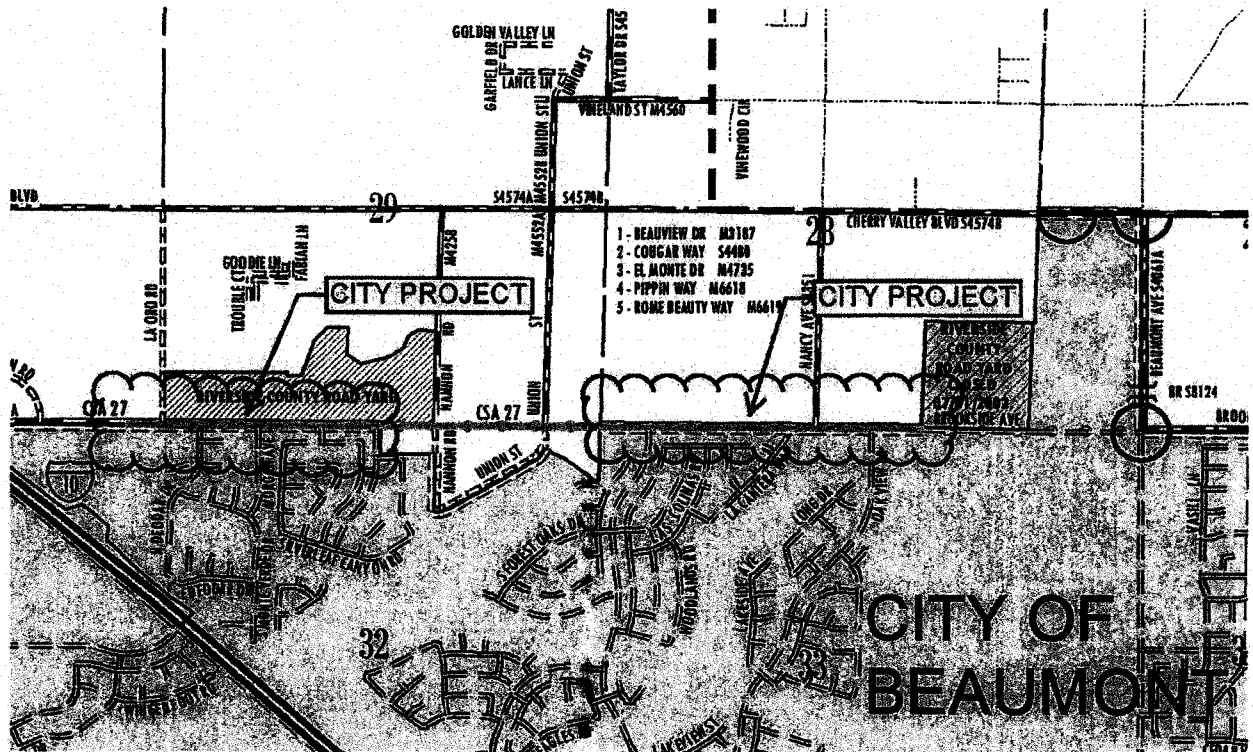
