

BACKGROUND:

1. The donation to the Fire & Burn Foundation will help sponsor their annual 4-day camp for children ages 5-17 who have survived burns.
2. The donation to the Riverside Mayor's Office will be used to help fund a program that will place 15 social work interns at faith-based organizations to provide outreach, housing location, housing navigation and other needed services for the city's homeless population.
3. The donation to the Riverside Downtown Partnership will promote their Downtown Retail and Downtown Restaurant Programs, which help bring tourists and residents to the downtown area.
