



**BACKGROUND:** Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

1. Safe Alternatives for Everyone - \$2,500 the funding will be used to sponsor a fundraiser for SAFE, which provides wrap around services for families that are exposed to domestic violence trauma. In addition, SAFE offers Police Activities League where local law enforcement members mentor local youth/teens.
2. Rose Again Foundation - \$1,000 the funding will be utilized as a fundraiser for the Rose Again Foundation that serves foster children in the Southwest Riverside County area.
