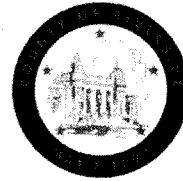

SUBJECT: RIVERSIDE UNIVERSITY HEALTH SYSTEM-MEDICAL CENTER: Ratification of the First Amendment to the Professional Services Agreement with The University of California, Riverside, UCR Health to provide Professional Family Medicine Services effective March 17, 2017; 4 years; District- All; [\$2,500,000 Annual]; Hospital Enterprise Funds.

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors:

1. Ratify and execute the First Amendment to the Professional Services Agreement with The University of California, Riverside, UCR Health to provide Professional Family Medicine Services effective March 17, 2017, not to exceed an annual amount of \$2,500,000, and
2. Authorize the Purchasing Agent, in accordance with Ordinance No. 459 and as approved by County Counsel to: (a) sign amendments that do not change the substantive terms of the agreement and (b) sign amendments to the compensation provisions that do not exceed ten percent (10%) annually.

BACKGROUND:

Summary

Riverside University Health System-Medical Center (RUHS-MC) has a residency program for Family Medicine with UC Riverside to provide the professional staff necessary for this program. UCR agreed to maintain an environment which is conducive to quality medical care provision, and training as it pertains to Family Practice services by providing qualified faculty to properly care for Riverside County patients.

The program encourages crucial dialogue between teaching staff and trainees through rounds, conferences, and patient care procedures. Faculty shall fulfill the faculty teaching duties as described in the Accreditation Council of Graduate Medical Education (ACGME) program requirements.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

The hospital, its site-based clinics and community-based clinics serve residents in all five Riverside County supervisorial districts, providing more than 450,000 patient encounters each year.

Riverside University Health System (RUHS) continues to contract with University of Riverside, UCR Health to obtain the professional services of a program director and faculty members for its family practice residency program. This will promote patient care and comply with requirements of California Code of Regulations ("CCR") Title 22 for acute care hospitals and CCR Title 10 for managed care.

Additional Fiscal Information


Optimal staffing is expected to consist of faculty physicians for the Family Residency Program and for the Access Clinic. Compensation is set at market rates. RUHS retains the right to bill and receive payment for all professional services rendered under this program.

Contract History and Price Reasonableness

On July 12, 2016, Agenda Item Number 3-31, approved a Professional Medical Services Agreement with University of California, Riverside, UCR Health to provide faculty members and a program director for the RUHS Family Medicine residency training program for \$2,400,000 per year.

This First Amendment modifies the number of faculty by adding a .3 FTE position to extend the Residency Program to the Access Clinic. In addition, the monthly fee for each full time faculty equivalent will increase from \$26,667 per month to \$27,600 per month. This is approximately a 3.5% increase that; in turn, increases the aggregate amount of the contract.

**FIRST AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT
BETWEEN
COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE
AND
THE UNIVERSITY OF CALIFORNIA, RIVERSIDE, UCR HEALTH
(Professional Medical Services Family Medicine)**

That certain agreement between the County of Riverside (COUNTY) on behalf of the Riverside University Health System Medical Center (HOSPITAL) and The Regents of the University of California, a public corporation on behalf of The University of California, Riverside, UCR Health (CONTRACTOR) approved by the Board of Supervisors on July 12, 2016, Agenda Item 3-31 (CONTRACT), is hereby amended for the first time effective March 17, 2017, as follows:


1. Delete sections 1.11, 1.12, 2.2.1, sections A.1, and B of Exhibit A and section 1.1 of Exhibit B.
2. Add a new paragraph 2.2.3:
"In addition to the above, CONTRACTOR will provide .3 full time FACULTY EQUIVALENT to provide PROFESSIONAL SERVICES in COUNTY's Access clinic. The initially approved PHYSICIAN to serve in this role is Emma Simmons. "
3. Replace the first sentence of section 1.2 of Exhibit B with:
"COUNTY shall pay to CONTRACTOR \$27,600.00 per month for each full time FACULTY EQUIVALENT who performs FACULTY SERVICES or PROFESSIONAL SERVICES. This monthly amount shall not be increased prior to July 1, 2018."
4. Replace section 2.0 of Exhibit B with:
"2.0 Maximum Annual Compensation
Maximum annual compensation payable under this agreement shall not exceed two million five-hundred thousand (\$2,500,000).
5. Add to Section 3.0 of Exhibit B:
3.1 CONTRACTOR shall cause each of its Physicians and, if applicable, ACPs, to


execute a form CMS 855-R and any other documents necessary to effectuate the reassignment of professional fees to COUNTY. As required by Medicare: (i) CONTRACTOR and COUNTY agree that CONTRACTOR shall be jointly and severally liable for any Medicare overpayments resulting from claims for the professional services where PHYSICIAN has not coded correctly and (ii) CONTRACTOR shall have unrestricted access to claims submitted by COUNTY for the Professional Services performed by CONTRACTOR's personnel.


3.2 CONTRACTOR and its personnel shall fully cooperate with HOSPITAL staff or any COUNTY billing, coding and collection contractors in billing third-party payers and patients for care provided by CONTRACTOR and its personnel under this Agreement. In particular, CONTRACTOR's personnel shall complete adequate and appropriate documentation in a timely manner relating to the services provided by them in compliance with federal, state and other payer requirements.


All other terms and conditions of the CONTRACT shall remain unchanged and in full force and effect.
