2. Approve the plans and specifications for the construction of the McKinley Street Reconstruction Project in the Community of Home Gardens; and
3. Authorize the Clerk of the Board to advertise for bids to be received by the office of the Director of Transportation and Land Management at the Transportation Annex located at 3525 14th Street, Riverside, CA 92501. All bids must be received up to the hour of 2:00 p.m., Wednesday, May 2, 2018 at which time bids will be opened; and
4. Direct the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors to file the Notice of Exemption with the County Clerk for posting within five (5) working days.

BACKGROUND:

Summary

The Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) provides for the construction of the McKinley Street Reconstruction Project from Indiana Avenue to Magnolia Avenue in the Community of Home Gardens.

Roadway reconstruction is needed due to deteriorated pavement condition. The scope of work includes removal and replacement of the existing asphalt concrete pavement with new hot mix asphalt. Additional improvements will include reconstruction of curb ramps to comply with Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) requirements, reconstruction of damaged sections of existing curb, gutter, sidewalk, cross gutter and spandrels, relocation and replacement of roadside signs, replacement of traffic loops, placement of traffic stripes and pavement markings and other associated work.

On April 28, 2017, Senate Bill 1 (SB1) was passed to improve the state's aging transportation infrastructure, particularly roads and bridges. Because of this, the County is now able to improve the condition of roads in need of resurfacing or reconstruction and has included them in the County Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). McKinley Street was initially identified as being in need of rehabilitation in 2006. Without SB1, this urgently needed road repair project would have been shelved until funding became available.

The submitted plans and specifications have been approved as to form by County Counsel.

The bid documents include the following bid schedules of work:

- Base Bid Sch. McKinley Street pavement reconstruction and associated work
- Alternate Bid Sch. 1: Manhole Adjustment for Western Municipal Water District (WMWD)
- Alternate Bid Sch. 2: Manhole Adjustment for Southern California Edison (SCE)
- Alternate Bid Sch. 3: Manhole Adjustment for AT&T

The Transportation Department will select the contractor based upon the lowest responsive and responsible bid of the sum of all bid schedules. The utility companies, WMWD, SCE and AT&T

will reimburse the construction cost for their respective alternate bid schedule if selected for award.

Environmental Findings

The County Transportation Department is requesting that the Board approve the Notice of Exemption which documents that the project consists of the maintenance, repair and minor alteration of an existing public facility and is exempt under Section 15301 (c) of the CEQA Guidelines.

Impact on Citizens and Businesses

The purpose of this project is to reconstruct a deteriorated segment of McKinley Street between Indiana Avenue and Magnolia Avenue to provide the public with a smooth paved roadway that will improve the safety and efficiency of vehicular traffic.

The work is scheduled to begin in summer of 2018. The work will be phased to keep the road open during construction as much as possible and will take approximately one month to complete.

The construction contract is estimated to cost approximately \$1,061,000 and will be funded with Gas Tax/SB-1 funds.



PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The County of Riverside Transportation Department proposes to reconstruct approximately 2,300 feet of roadway on McKinley Street from Indiana Avenue to Magnolia Avenue. McKinley Street is a four lane road that is 64 feet wide and is classified as a Secondary Road in the County of Riverside's General Plan. The proposed improvements consist of removing the existing pavement to a depth of 0.50 feet, and paving back the roadway with 0.50 feet of Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA).

The proposed project will include:

- Reconstruction of curb ramps to meet ADA standards;
- Reconstruction of damaged sidewalk, spandrel, cross gutter, and inlet catch basin;
- Striping of roadway, including application of pavement markings and reflectors;
- Replacing Traffic Loops
- Salvaging and replacing of existing signs and installation of new signs
- Utility adjustments

No additional right-of-way will be required to construct the proposed improvements. All improvements are to be done on the same footprint of the existing roadway. The project improvements will not raise the existing roadway profile

ENVIRONMENTAL ANALYSIS:

Because the Project consists of operation, maintenance and repair of an existing public facility; and there is no expansion of an existing roadway, this Project qualifies for a Class 1 Categorical Exemption under Section 15301 (c) of the CEQA Guidelines. Furthermore, for public safety, existing public facilities (e.g. street lights, fire hydrants, pull boxes, power poles, utilities) will be protected in place and the reconstruction of operational features, such as curb and gutters, sidewalks, and spandrel will be completed.


CEQA Finding:

The Transportation Department staff conducted a review of the project and determined that the project qualifies for a Class 1 Categorical Exemption under Section 15301 (c) of the CEQA Guidelines, Article 19 commencing with Section 15300. In accordance with Section 15301 (c), Class 1 projects consist of the operation, repair and maintenance of existing public facilities, such as highways, streets, sidewalks, gutters, bicycle and pedestrian trails and similar facilities.

The Riverside County Transportation Department has found that the above-described project is exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), based on the following:
