

**BACKGROUND:**

**Summary**

The Riverside County Flood Control and Water Conservation District (District) in partnership with the Natural Resources Conservation Service (NRCS), and the Meadowview Community Association (HOA), is proposing to design and construct the Meadowview Stream Restoration Project (project). The project proposes to restore 1,220 lineal feet of streambank (approximately 4.25 acres). The District's cost of implementing the project is estimated at \$362,195.00. The District proposes to fund the design, construction and construction inspection costs for the physical modifications only. Surface improvements and future operation and maintenance costs associated with the project will accrue to the HOA.

Pursuant to Section 15333(d)(5) of the California Environmental Quality Act Statutes and Guidelines, small habitat restoration projects of less than five acres are categorically exempt from CEQA provided that there would be no significant adverse impact to endangered, rare or threatened species or their habitat, and that there are no hazardous materials at or around the project site that may be disturbed or removed and that the project will not result in cumulative impacts. Based on the analysis that has been conducted for the project, none of the aforementioned conditions apply to the project and the project is consistent with the Class 33 Categorical Exemption. As such, in accordance with CEQA a Notice of Exemption (NOE) has been prepared by the District and submitted to the Board herein. The NOE should be filed with the County Clerk by the Clerk of the Board no more than five days after the date of the project approval.



15 WHEREAS, the Project is generally bounded to the north and to the west by undeveloped

18 (approximately 4.25 acres) of streambed; and,

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WHEREAS, the District has reviewed the Project and determined that it is exempt from CEQA pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines Section 15333 which exempts "Small Habitat Restoration Projects"; and,

WHEREAS, all provisions of CEQA and the District Rules to Implement the California Environmental Quality Act have been satisfied; and,

WHEREAS, the District is an active participant and Permittee in the Western Riverside County Multiple Species Habitat Conservation Plan ("MSHCP"); and,

WHEREAS, the Project is in compliance with Sections 6.1.2, 6.1.3, 6.3.2, 6.1.4, 7.0 and Appendix C of the MSHCP as supported by the conclusions of the Western Riverside County Multiple Species Habitat Conservation Plan Consistency Analysis that was prepared for the Project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, FOUND, DETERMINED AND ORDERED by the Board of Supervisors of the Riverside County Flood Control and Water Conservation District, in regular session assembled on April 10, 2018, based upon the evidence and testimony presented on the matter, both written and oral, that:

1. The Project is in compliance with Section 18 of the District Act. The Section 18 Map is attached hereto as Attachment "A"; an illustration of the Project's cross sections are attached hereto as Attachment "B"; the Engineer's Statement is attached hereto as Attachment "C"; and the Declaration of Postings for the Ronald H. Roberts Temecula Public Library, the County Clerk, and the District are attached hereto as Attachment "D".

2. The environmental impacts of the Project have been sufficiently assessed and a determination has been made that the Project is exempt from CEQA pursuant to State CEQA

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Guidelines Section 15333 based on the information set forth in the Notice of Exemption which is incorporated herein by this reference.

3. All obligations set forth to the District pursuant to applicable sections of the MSHCP have been analyzed and shall be implemented by the District as prescribed in the MSHCP Implementation Agreement.

4. The Project is approved and the District is hereby authorized to proceed with the Project.



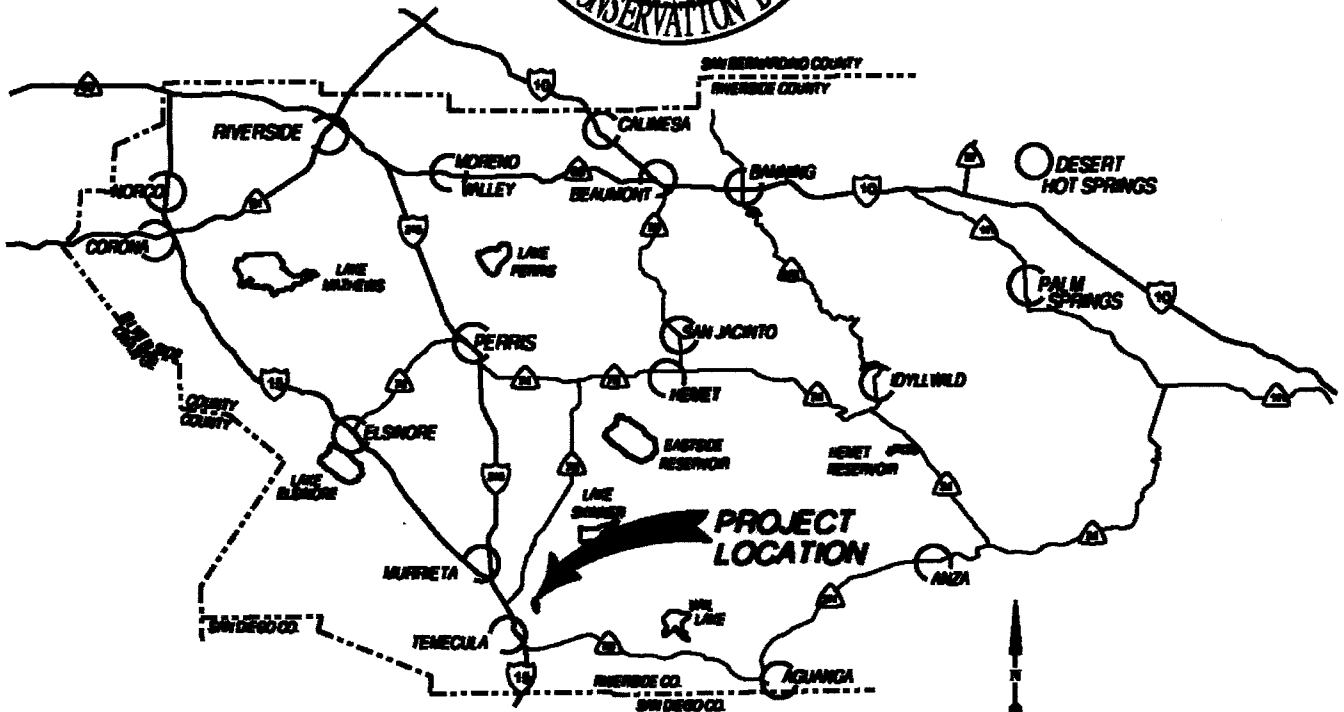

MAP**

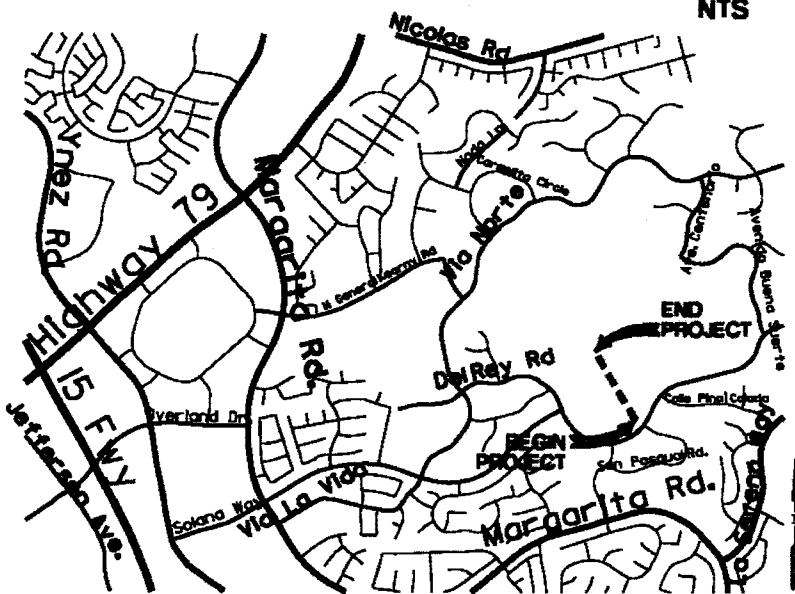


**MEADOWVIEW STREAMBANK

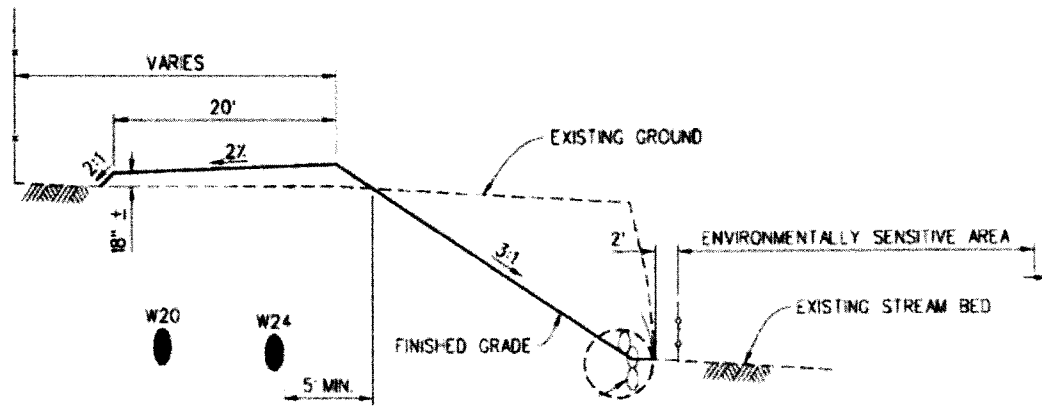


**PROJECT DESCRIPTION:**  
The Meadowview Streambank Restoration Project is a habitat restoration project of 4.25 acres. The project includes stream stabilization with native vegetation and bioengineering techniques with the primary purpose to reduce erosion and sedimentation. These techniques include laying back cut banks and adding rock, compost roll, and vegetation planting and staking along the projects 1200-foot length. All disturbed areas will be revegetated with native plant species.

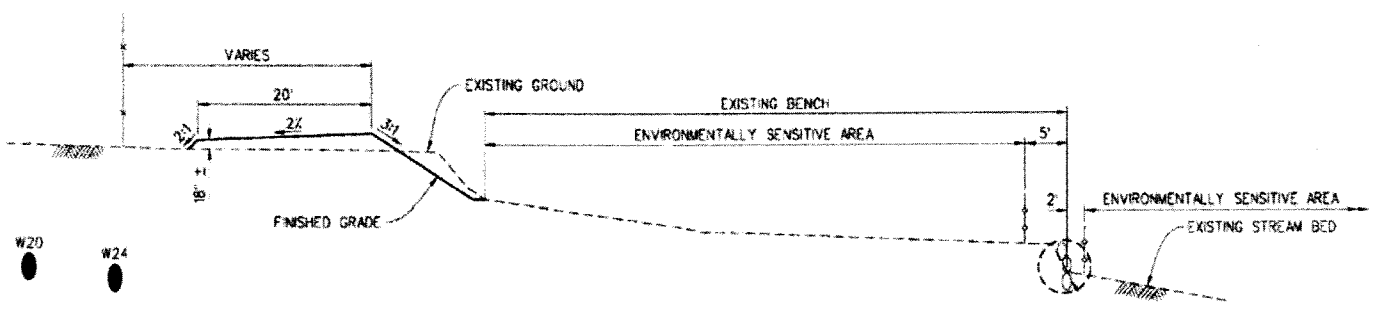




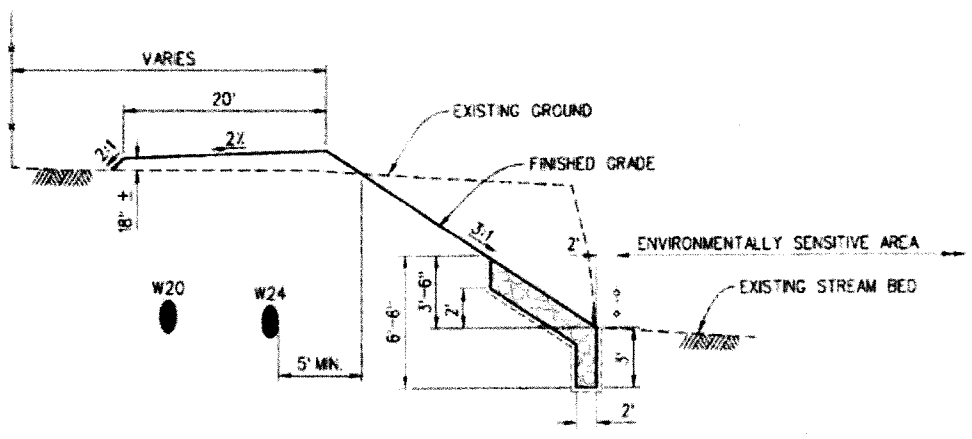

### **Meadowview Stream Restoration Project**

#### **ENGINEER'S STATEMENT**

The proposed Meadowview Stream Restoration Project is located in the city of Temecula, Riverside County, California. The project site is generally bounded to the north and to the west by undeveloped land, to the east by Meadowview Trail, and to the south by Del Rey Road. The project consists of approximately 1,200 lineal feet (4.25 acres) of stream stabilization with native vegetation and bioengineering techniques, such as laying back cut banks, adding rock riprap, compost rolls, and hydroseed in all disturbed areas. Completion of the Meadowview Stream Restoration Project will improve public safety, water quality and the natural environment by reducing bank erosion and restoring the native habitat. The Meadowview Community Association will assume operation and maintenance of the project upon project completion. The District's estimated cost for construction of the proposed project is approximately \$210,641.23.





**Project Title:** Meadowview Stream Restoration Project

**Project Location – City:** Temecula

**Project Location – County:** Riverside

The project is located on the west side of Del Rey Road approximately 200 feet south of Calle Pina Colada on APN 919-340-023 in the city of Temecula. The project is located in Township 7 South, Range 2 West, Section 31 of the Murrieta USGS 7.5 Series Topographic Quadrangle map.

**Project Description:** The Meadowview Stream Restoration Project is a 4.25-acre habitat restoration project that involves streambed stabilization with native vegetation and bio-engineering techniques such as laying back cut banks and adding rock, compost rolls and vegetation planting and staking along the entire project length (1,200 feet). The project has been designed in coordination with the Natural Resource Conservation Service (NRCS) to address the severely incised and unstable stream banks, minimize associated erosion and water quality issues, and ultimately restore the functions and values of the streambed and bank. Upon completion, the project will improve public safety, water quality and the natural environment by reducing bank erosion and restoring the native habitat. The project has been reviewed by the environmental resource agencies and the biological study that was conducted for the project concluded that there would not be an adverse impact to special status species or their habitat. The project site is not located on any list compiled pursuant to Section 65962.5 of the Government Code, hazardous wastes/materials are not known to be present in or around the project site and no cumulative impacts are expected to occur.

**Public Agency Approving Project:** Riverside County Flood Control and Water Conservation District

**Name of Person or Agency Carrying Out Project:** Riverside County Flood Control and Water Conservation District, NRCS and the Meadowview Homeowners Association.

**Exempt Status:** Class 33 Categorical Exemption [Section 15333(d)(5)]

**Reasons Why Project is Exempt:** The project qualifies for a "Class 33 Categorical Exemption" pursuant to Article 19 of the State CEQA Guidelines Section 15333, Small Habitat Restoration Projects, which states "Class 33 consists of projects not to exceed five acres in size to assure the maintenance, restoration, enhancement or protection of habitat for fish, plants and wildlife". Section 15333(d)(5) specifically describes stream or river bank stabilization as an example of the activities that are permitted under this exemption. It should also be noted that the project is under five acres which is consistent with the acreage constraint associated with this exemption.

Based upon the exemptions identified above, the District hereby concludes that no significant environmental impacts are anticipated to occur and the project as proposed is exempt under CEQA. No further environmental analysis is warranted.

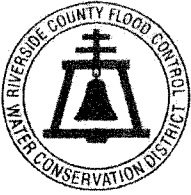

## CEQA Environmental Document Filing Fees

CDFW imposes and collects a filing fee to defray the costs of managing and protecting California's vast fish and wildlife resources, including, but not limited to, consulting with other public agencies, reviewing environmental documents, recommending mitigation measures, and developing monitoring programs.

### Annual Fee Adjustments

Annual filing fee adjustments are posted on CDFW's website prior to November 1 of the year before they become effective.

### Payment of Fees

The project proponent is responsible for payment of the filing fee (Fish & G. Code, § 711.4). Filing Fees are due at the time a Notice of Determination is filed with the county clerk's office (local lead agency), or with the State Clearinghouse (state lead agency). Fees due for Certified Regulatory Program (/Conservation/CEQA/Procedures/Commission) notices are due to CDFW directly and before the respective Notice of Decision is filed with the Secretary for Natural Resources.

## Exemptions and No Effect Determinations

The CEQA filing fee will be waived if a project will have no effect (/Conservation/CEQA/NED) on fish and wildlife (Fish & G. Code, § 711.4, subd. (c)(2)(A)). Additionally, projects that are statutorily or categorically exempt from CEQA are also not subject to the filing fee and do not require a no effect determination (Cal. Code Regs., tit. 14, §§ 15260-15333; Fish & G. Code, § 711.4, subd. (d)(1)). Only CDFW staff is responsible for determining whether a project will qualify for a No Effect Determination and if the CEQA filing fee will be waived.

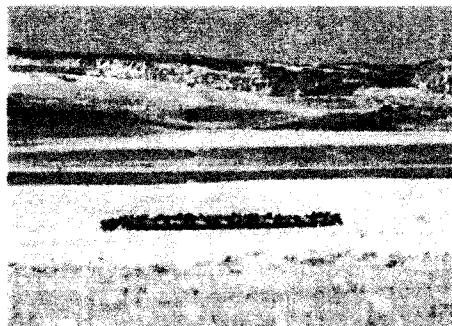

**BACKGROUND:**

**Summary**

Section 18 of the District Act requires the Board of Supervisors to hold a public hearing for the purpose of considering all comments regarding proposed facilities before authorizing construction of such facilities.

The Riverside County Flood Control and Water Conservation District (District) in partnership with the Natural Resources Conservation Service (NRCS) and Meadowview Community Association (HOA), is proposing to design and construct the Meadowview Stream Restoration Project (project). The project proposes the restoration of approximately 1,200 lineal feet of streambank totaling 4.25 acres. The District's cost of implementing the project is estimated at \$210,641.23. The District proposes to fund the design, construction and construction inspection costs for the physical modifications only. Surface improvements and future operation and maintenance costs associated with the project will accrue to the HOA.

Pursuant to Section 15333(d)(5) of the California Environmental Quality Act Statutes and Guidelines, small habitat restoration projects of less than five acres are categorically exempt from California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) provided that there would be no significant adverse impact to endangered, rare or threatened species or their habitat and that there are no hazardous materials at or around the project site that may be disturbed or removed and the project will not result in cumulative impacts. Based on the analysis that has been conducted for the project, none of the aforementioned conditions apply to the project and the project is consistent with the Class 33 Categorical Exemption. As such, in accordance with CEQA, the Clerk of the Board will file a Notice of Exemption with the County Clerk within five days of the Board approving the project if said project is approved at the April 10, 2018 Board of Supervisors meeting.
