



**BACKGROUND:**

1. The funds awarded to the Riverside Police Officer's Association will fund two separate projects. First, it will assist with the redesign and remodel of the kindergarten playground at Alcott Elementary.
2. The donation to the Boy Scouts of America will help fund scholarships for kids to attend camp as well as other programs offered by the scouts, regardless of their ability to pay.
3. The donation to Gateway to College will help fund the Student Advisory Council, which provides high school students with traditional high school activities while they prepare for college.
4. The funds awarded to the City of Norco will help sponsor their annual "Wheelchair Basketball Tournament" which is part of National Wheelchair Basketball Week, which is sanctioned by the NWBA (National Wheelchair Basketball Association).
