

BACKGROUND: Community Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

1. Fire & Burn Foundation funding will be used to support the Embers of Hope Camp session. The camp provides each child with a "tool box" of coping skills that can help them overcome the scrutiny of their peers and others. The children are assisted in transitioning from a burn victim status to a burn survivor with the tools given.

2. Nuevo Citizens Patrol support will be utilized for their programs and services that bring safety to our surrounding communities. The Nuevo Citizens Patrol provides first responder type services while at the same time being CERT equipped in the event of an emergency.

3. Riverside County Office of Education Foundation will use their funding towards opportunities for scholarships that will assist disadvantaged students and further assist them with their goals for college such as the Come Back Kids program.

4. Time is Creeping Up Productions, Inc. will utilize their funding to support the programs and services that benefit foster children in our district whom have become victims of cancer and abuse.
