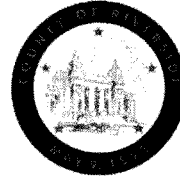



**RECOMMENDED MOTION:** That the Board of Supervisors:

1. Find that the De Palma Road Reconstruction Project is categorically exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines Section 15301 (c) - Existing Facilities; and
2. Approve the plans and specifications for the construction of the De Palma Road Reconstruction Project, in the Community of Temescal Valley; and
3. Authorize the Clerk of the Board to advertise for bids to be received by the office of the Director of Transportation and Land Management at the Transportation Annex located at 3525 14th Street, Riverside, CA 92501. All bids must be received up to the hour of 2:00 p.m., Wednesday, May 16, 2018 at which time bids will be opened; and
4. Direct the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors to file the Notice of Exemption with the County Clerk for posting within five (5) working days.

**BACKGROUND:**

**Summary**

The Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) provides for the construction of the De Palma Road Reconstruction Project from Santiago Canyon Road to Horsethief Canyon Road, an approximately 1.4 miles segment, in the Community of Temescal Valley.

Roadway reconstruction is needed due to deteriorated pavement conditions. The proposed reconstruction of De Palma Road consists of grinding the existing pavement, re-grading the surface and placement of new asphalt concrete pavement. De Palma Road is classified as a Major Highway in the circulation element of the County of Riverside's General Plan.

Additional improvements will include construction of concrete approach slabs at the De Palma Road bridge crossing Indian Wash and at the De Palma Road bridge crossing Horsethief Wash, to provide a gradual transition between the roadway and bridge decks.

On April 28, 2017, Senate Bill 1 (SB1) was passed to improve the state's aging transportation infrastructure, particularly roads and bridges. Because of this, the County is now able to improve the condition of roads in need of resurfacing or reconstruction, and has included them in the County TIP. The De Palma Road reconstruction project is one of the projects approved for use of the new Gas Tax/SB-1 funds. Without SB1 this needed road repair project would have been shelved until funding became available.

The submitted plans and specifications have been approved as to form by County Counsel.

The bid documents include the following bid schedules of work:

Base Bid Schedule - De Palma Road reconstruction and associated work

The Transportation Department will select the contractor based upon the lowest responsive and responsible bid of the sum of all bid schedules.

**Environmental Findings**

The County Transportation Department is requesting that the Board approve the Notice of Exemption which documents that the project consists of the maintenance, repair and minor alteration of an existing public facility and is exempt under Section 15301 (c) of the CEQA Guidelines.

**Impact on Citizens and Businesses**

The purpose of this project is to rehabilitate a deteriorated segment of De Palma Road between Santiago Canyon Road and Horsethief Canyon Road to provide the public with a smooth paved roadway that will improve the safety and efficiency of vehicular traffic.

The work is scheduled to begin in the summer of 2018. The work will be phased to keep the road open during construction as much as possible and will take approximately two months to complete.


**Additional Fiscal Information**

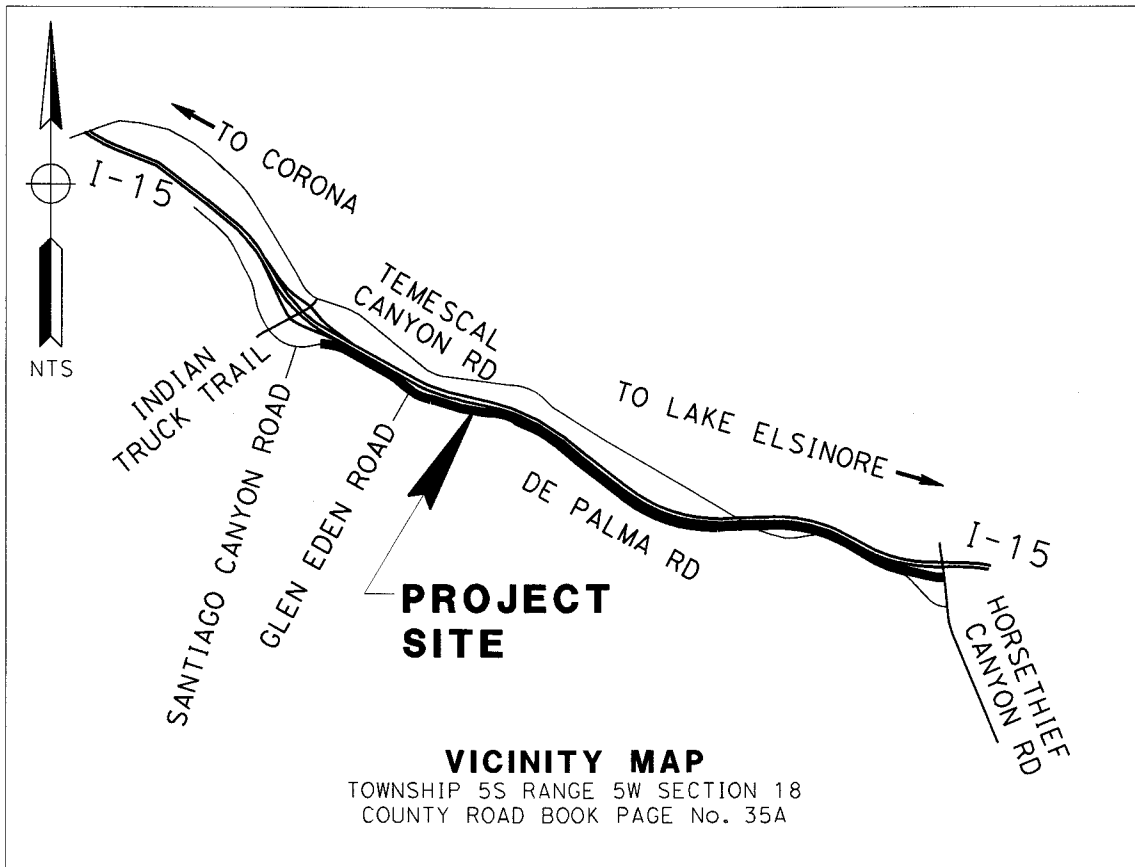
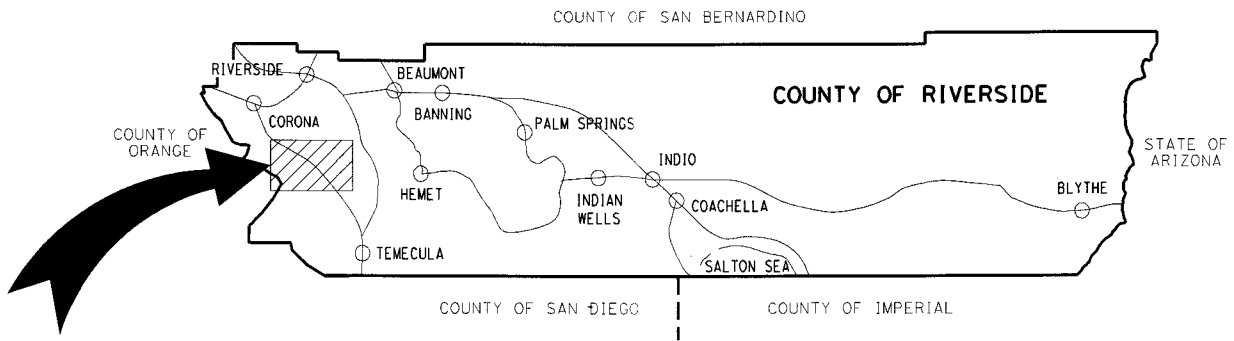

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The Riverside County Transportation Department (RCTD) proposes to resurface approximately 7,300 feet of De Palma Road from Santiago Canyon Road to Horsethief Canyon Road. The road is one lane in each direction of travel and varies between 29-80 feet in width. The project will include the following:

- Pulverizing the roadway then overlaying with hot mix asphalt.
Widening of paved shoulders
Reconstruction of asphalt concrete dike and overside drain.
Replacement of guardrail and placement of miscellaneous asphalt concrete, railings, and barricades.
Construct new approach slabs at both bridges within project
Utility adjustments, including drainage inlets
Striping of roadway, including pavement markers and reflectors.
Remove/Salvage and replace signs

ENVIRONMENTAL ANALYSIS:

The proposed project does not require additional Right of Way nor Temporary Construction Easements. All improvements are to be done on the same footprint of the existing road. The project improvements will raise existing roadway profile by 0.45 feet.

In accordance with Section 7.1 of the Western Riverside County MSHCP, necessary operation and maintenance along existing roadways are considered a covered activity outside cell criteria areas. The project will comply with MSHCP construction guidelines and BMP's.

The Riverside County Transportation Department Staff conducted a review of the above referenced project and has determined that the proposal qualifies for a Categorical Exemption per the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Guidelines.

The Riverside County Transportation Department has found that the above-described project is exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), based on the following:

Section 15301 (c) - Existing Facilities - The project proposes to resurface De Palma Road. This minor alteration to the existing roadway involves negligible or no expansion of use and is exempt from CEQA under Section 15301 (c). The improvements are consistent with Section 15301(c) because the project is repair and maintenance of an existing road and associated facilities.



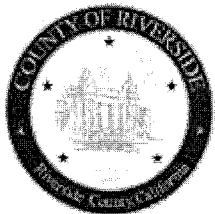
