

BACKGROUND:

Summary

The passing of SB-1 by the State legislature in April 2017 included the creation of the Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Program and the Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account (RMRA), which will provide a much needed infusion of funds for transportation improvements. The SB-1/RMRA fund is restricted to roadway rehabilitation and maintenance. SB-1 also provides for the State's payback of funds borrowed from Gas Tax and the gradual restoration of the portion of State Gas Tax funds currently being diverted to pay off State transportation bonds.

SB 1 includes accountability and transparency provisions to ensure that the residents of unincorporated County of Riverside are aware of local projects proposed to be funded with SB 1 funds. California Transportation Commission (CTC) Guidelines requires that in order to receive SB-1/RMRA funding, counties must provide evidence to the California Transportation Commission (CTC) by May 1, 2018 that the county budget includes a list of projects planned to be funded in FY 2018/2019. The list must include a description and the location of each proposed project, a proposed schedule for the project's completion, and the estimated useful life of the improvement. See attachment A for the list of proposed projects to be funded with SB-1/RMRA funding.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

Because of the SB-1/RMRA funding, the County is able to improve the condition of County maintained roads that are in need of resurfacing or reconstruction.

Cities and counties own and operate more than 81 percent of streets and roads in California. Improving and maintaining the local streets and road system will improve the quality of life for the public.

Additional Fiscal Information

All projects listed on Attachment-A are included in the 2017/18 Annual Report of the Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) as approved by the Board of Supervisors under agenda item 3.20 of October 3, 2017.

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No General funds will be used for these projects.

5 **SB1: THE ROAD REPAIR AND ACCOUNTABILITY ACT**

7 WHEREAS, Senate Bill 1 (SB 1), the Road Repair and Accountability Act of 2017
8 (Chapter 5, Statutes of 2017) was passed by the Legislature and Signed into law by the
9 Governor in April 2017 in order to address the significant multi-modal transportation funding
10 shortfalls statewide; and

11 WHEREAS, SB 1 includes accountability and transparency provisions that will
12 ensure the residents of unincorporated County of Riverside are aware of the projects proposed
13 for funding in our community and which projects have been completed each fiscal year; and

14 WHEREAS, in order to receive funding from the Road Maintenance and
15 Rehabilitation Account (RMRA), created by SB 1, all projects proposed to receive RMRA
16 funding in the County of Riverside, the Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside must
17 approve a list of projects which shall include a description and the location of each proposed
18 project, a proposed schedule for the project's completion, and the estimated useful life of the
19 improvement; and

20 WHEREAS, the County of Riverside, will receive an estimated \$30,570,000 in
21 funding in Fiscal Year 2018-19 from SB 1; and

22 WHEREAS, the County of Riverside is programming the entire estimated amount
23 of FY 2018-19 SB 1 funds (RMRA and non-RMRA) of \$30,570,000 to the projects listed in
Attachment-A; and

WHEREAS, the County of Riverside used a Pavement Management System to
develop the SB 1 project list shown on Attachment-A to ensure revenues are being used on
the highest priority and cost-effective projects that also meet the communities priorities for
transportation investment; and
