

2. Perris Valley Chamber of Commerce funding will assist with economic development, programs and services that are provided to the community and small businesses.
3. Riverside Art Museum funding will support the programs and services that serve Riverside County, such as the Cheech Marin Center for Chicano Art, Culture and Industry of the Riverside Art Museum.
