#### BACKGROUND:

### **Summary**

The Department of Environmental Health (DEH) currently occupies a 4,300 square foot facility located at 38740 Sky Canyon, #8, Murrieta, California. DEH must relocate due to the inadequate size of the existing location and limited unsecured parking space for both county and public vehicles. In addition to the space concerns for current staff and the public, DEH is seeking additional space for the Environmental Protection Oversight personnel, as well as a secured parking space for county vehicles as a prevention measure for vandalism. Therefore, in order to improve the services currently provided to the public and provide adequate room for staff, new office space in the Southwest County area of Riverside County is requested.

DEH has received the in-principle endorsement from EDA. This document is attached.

# Impact on Residents and Businesses

DEH's continued presence in this region will provide a positive environmental impact to the community through continued implementation of programs and services throughout southwest Riverside County.

#### **Additional Fiscal Information**

No additional funding is required at this time relative to approval of this in-principle request.

#### Contract History and Price Reasonableness

DEH entered into a lease agreement at 38740 Sky Canyon, #8, Murrieta, CA on June 27, 2000. Since then, three amendments to renew the lease have been previously submitted and approved by the Board of Supervisors. The lease term for the current facility is due to expire on September 30, 2018. At this time, the current facility no longer meets the needs of the department.
