BACKGROUND:

Summary

The Riverside University Health System – Behavioral Health (RUHS-BH) is in the process of implementing tenant improvements at 19531 McLane Street in Palm Springs where the Desert Adult FSP is currently located. Tenant Improvements include adding a second story and additional offices to allow the Desert Adult FSP room for expansion. Temporarily relocating the Desert FSP into a leased office space would allow tenant improvements to be completed in one phase, whereas not relocating the program would require a two-phase approach, extending the duration of the construction and adding costs to the project. In addition, this will minimize disruption to client care and maintain an adequate amount of staff space.

Program

Full Service Partnership programs provide intensive wellness and recovery based services for previously un-served or underserved individuals who carry a serious mental health diagnosis and who are also homeless, at risk of homelessness, and/or have experienced numerous psychiatric hospitalizations or incarcerations related to their mental health disorder. Services are provided by a staff of licensed mental health professionals (Psychiatrists, Licensed Clinical Social Workers, Marriage and Family Therapists and Behavioral Health Specialists, Peer Support Specialists and Community Services Assistants). The provider team collaborates with consumers to develop a plan that responds to each consumer's goals for recovery.

Federal and State funding sources will be used to pay for the lease and no additional County funds are required.
