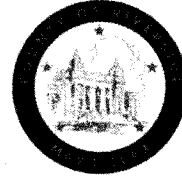



BACKGROUND:

Summary

On January 4, 2018, the Mayor for the City of Rancho Mirage approved the First Amendment to the Agreement for Law Enforcement Services Between the City of Rancho Mirage and the County of Riverside. This amendment modifies the level of law enforcement service provided by the Sheriff's Department with the addition of two (2) Deputy Sheriff positions. County Counsel has approved the amendment as to form.

The additional two (2) Deputy Sheriff positions are expected to start in FY2018-19, therefore no budget adjustment is requested at this time. Sheriff's staff anticipates this change will result in an estimated increase of \$726,654 in Contract Law Enforcement Revenue for FY2018-19 and the increase in expenditures will be included in the FY2018-19 budget request.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

This is an agreement with the Sheriff's Department for law enforcement services, which the City of Rancho Mirage approved and executed on behalf of its citizens. All costs for this service will be fully recovered through Board-approved rates.





FIRST AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT FOR
LAW ENFORCEMENT SERVICES BETWEEN
THE CITY OF RANCHO MIRAGE AND THE COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE

IT IS MUTUALLY AGREED that the Agreement for Law Enforcement Services between the City of Rancho Mirage, a Charter City, and the County of Riverside, a political subdivision of the State of California, on behalf of the Riverside County Sheriff's Department, and approved by the Board of Supervisors on September 27, 2016, for services effective July 1, 2016 through June 30, 2021, is hereby amended in the following respects, and all other terms and conditions of the Agreement remain in full force and effect:
