RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors:





BACKGROUND:

Summary

On February 14, 2018, the Mayor for the City of Eastvale approved the First Amendment to the Agreement for Law Enforcement Services Between the City of Eastvale and the County of Riverside. This amendment modifies the level of law enforcement service provided by the Sheriff's Department with the addition of three (3) Deputy Sheriff positions. County Counsel has approved the amendment as to form.

Sheriff's staff has recommended budget adjustments that correspond with the additional (3) Deputy Sheriff positions. Sheriff's staff anticipates this change will result in an estimated increase of \$1,037,404 in Contract Law Enforcement Revenue for FY2018-19. The Department is recommending these budget adjustments for next fiscal year as the new positions will not be added until after July 1, 2018.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

This is an agreement with the Sheriff's Department for law enforcement services, which the City of Eastvale approved and executed on behalf of its citizens.

Additional Fiscal Information

All costs for this service will be fully recovered through Board-approved rates.

FIRST AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT FOR
LAW ENFORCEMENT SERVICES BETWEEN
THE CITY OF EASTVALE AND THE COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE

IT IS MUTUALLY AGREED that the Agreement for Law Enforcement Services between the City of Eastvale, a General Law City, and the County of Riverside, a political subdivision of the State of California, on behalf of the Riverside County Sheriff's Department, and approved by the Board of Supervisors on August 23, 2016, for services effective July 1, 2016 through June 30, 2021, is hereby amended in the following respects, and all other terms and conditions of the Agreement remain in full force and effect:

LEVEL OF SERVICE

Average Patrol Services

100 supported hours per day. (Approximate equivalent of 20.5 Deputy Sheriff positions @ 1780 annual productive hours per position.)

Dedicated Positions

Two (2) Deputy Sheriff (fully supported) positions – Traffic Enforcement Officers

Two (2) Deputy Sheriff (fully supported) positions – Zone Policing Officers

Two (2) Deputy Sheriff (fully supported) position – Motor Officers

Two (2) Community Service Officer II positions – Traffic Enforcement
