

1. Find that the Borel Road Resurfacing Project and Rancho California Road Resurfacing Project are categorically exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines Section 15301 (c) - Existing Facilities; and
2. Approve the plans and specifications for the construction of the Borel Road Resurfacing Project in the community of French Valley; and Rancho California Road Resurfacing Project, in the community of Rancho California; and
3. Authorize the Clerk of the Board to advertise for bids to be received by the office of the Director of Transportation and Land Management at the Transportation Annex located at 3525 14th Street, Riverside, CA 92501. All bids must be received up to the hour of 2:00 p.m., Wednesday, June 13, 2018 at which time bids will be opened; and
4. Direct the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors to file the Notice of Exemption with the County Clerk for posting within five (5) working days.

BACKGROUND:

Summary

The Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) provides for the resurfacing of Borel Road from Auld Road to Buck Road in the Community of French Valley, and resurfacing of Rancho California Road from Monte De Oro to Buck Road in the Community of Rancho California.

Roadway resurfacing is needed due to the deteriorated pavement conditions. These two resurfacing projects were combined to bid as one project to reduce overhead costs and receive more favorable unit costs associated with larger quantities of work.

The proposed improvements on **Borel Road** includes removal and replacement of the existing asphalt concrete (AC) pavement with new hot mix asphalt. Additional improvements will include construction of driveway approaches, reconstruction of AC dike, catch basin, and overside drain, shoulder backing, installation of roadside signs, placement of traffic stripes and pavement markings, and other associated work.

The proposed improvements on **Rancho California Road** includes removal and replacement of the existing AC pavement with new hot mix asphalt. Additional improvements will include construction of cross-gutter and spandrel, AC driveways, reconstruction of AC dike, shoulder backing, installation of roadside signs, placement of traffic stripes and pavement markings, and other associated work.

On April 28, 2017, Senate Bill 1 (SB1) was passed to improve the state's aging transportation infrastructure, particularly roads and bridges. Because of this, the County is now able to improve the condition of roads in need of resurfacing or reconstruction and has included them in the County Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). Borel Road and Rancho California Road are urgently needed to improve aging roads in a state of disrepair. Without SB1 these urgently needed road repair projects would have been shelved until funding became available.

The submitted plans and specifications have been approved as to form by County Counsel.

The Transportation Department will select the contractor based upon the lowest responsive and responsible bid of the sum of all bid schedules. The utility companies, MWD and EMWD will reimburse the construction cost for their respective alternate bid schedules if selected for award.

Environmental Findings

The County Transportation Department is requesting that the Board approve the Notices of Exemption which documents that the projects consists of the maintenance, repair and minor alteration of an existing public facility and is exempt under Section 15301 (c) of the CEQA Guidelines.

Impact on Citizens and Businesses

The purpose of this project is to reconstruct deteriorated segment of Borel Road and Rancho California Road to provide the public with a smooth paved roadway that will improve the safety and efficiency of vehicular traffic.

The work is scheduled to begin in summer of 2018. The work will be phased to keep the roads open during construction as much as possible and will take approximately two months to complete.

Additional Fiscal Information

The construction contract is estimated to cost approximately \$2,259,693 and will be funded with Gas Tax/SB-1 funds.

There are no General Funds used in this project.

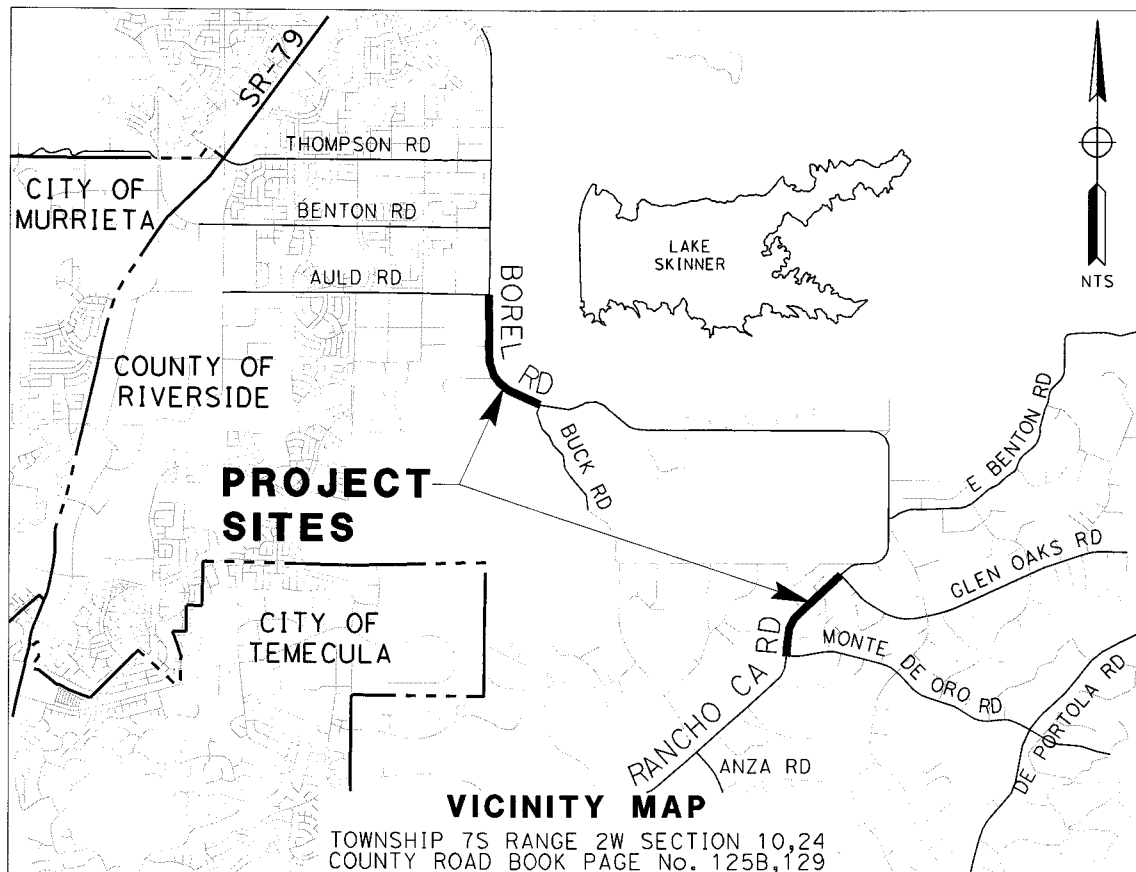
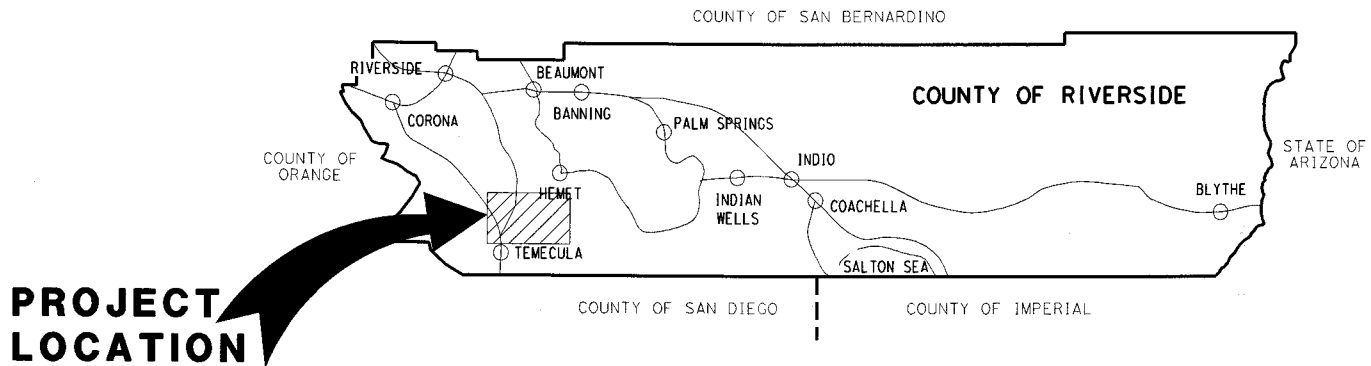

PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

The Riverside County Transportation Department (RCTD) proposes to resurface Rancho California Road from Monte De Oro Road to Buck Road for approximately 0.90 miles. Rancho California Road is currently a two lane road with a width varying from 27 to 64 feet. The road travels in a West-East direction and is classified as a Mountain Arterial Highway per the County of Riverside General Plan. The project will include the following:

- Grind existing pavement section in place to the depth of 0.67' and remove 0.35' of material
- Place 0.35' of HMA Type "A" PG 70-10, 1" Mix
- Overlay with 0.17' RHMA PG 64-10 Type "G" ½" mix
- Construct shoulder backing and AC dikes and driveways
- Place AC over-side drain
- Reconstruct concrete spandrel
- Re-apply striping and pavement markers
- Remove/salvage and replace signs

ENVIRONMENTAL ANALYSIS:

The proposed project does not require additional Right of Way nor Temporary Construction Easements. The project will raise the profile of the roadway through the project limits by approximately 0.17 feet.

This project is subject to compliance with the Western Riverside County MSHCP. In accordance with Section 7.1 of the Western Riverside County MSHCP, necessary operation and maintenance along existing roadways are considered a covered activity outside cell criteria areas. This project is considered to be a safety improvement project under operation and maintenance and therefore is a covered activity. The project will comply with MSHCP construction guidelines and BMP's.



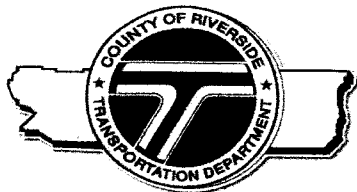

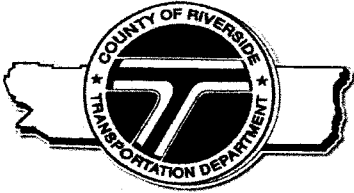

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The Riverside County Transportation Department (RCTD) proposes to resurface approximately 1 mile of Borel Road from 200 feet North of Buck Road to Auld Road. Borel Road is classified as a Major Highway in the County of Riverside's General Plan. Borel Road currently ranges from 26-52 feet wide with dikes at various segments of the roadway. The project will include the following:

- Pulverizing the roadway width and overlaying the pulverized material with Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA).
- Pulverizing up to six feet of the dirt shoulder near the intersection of Borel and Auld Road followed by overlaying the pulverized material with HMA.
- Construction of some driveway tie-ins
- Reconstruction of asphalt concrete dikes and inlets
- Placement of overside drain, safety edges, and shoulder backing
- Utility adjustments
- Striping of roadway, including pavement markers and reflectors
- Salvage/removal and installation of new signs



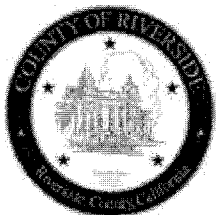
