BACKGROUND: Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

- 1. Rancho Damacitas \$2,000 will go to support the classes, one-on-one coaching, and activities within Empowerment Village that help struggling single moms and their young children achieve self-sufficiency, breaking their dependency on the welfare system, and keeping children out of the foster care system and families intact.
- 2. Hemet Community Pantry \$5,000 the funding will be used for food purchase and the senior homebound food delivery program. In addition, the funding will serve with rent and utility assistance for low-income individuals.
- 3. Idyllwild Help Center \$2,000 the funding will be utilized for food boxes, rental and utility assistance for low-income individuals living in the Idyllwild, Pine Cove and Mountain Center areas
- 4. Women's Breast Cancer Resource Center \$2,500 the funding will be used for the Pink Ribbon Assistance Program. This program offers financial assistance and resources to women who are struggling financially and currently in active breast cancer treatment.
- 5. California VFW Motorcycle Club \$1,000 to purchase and deliver food boxes for veterans, returning troops families and widows.
- 6. Community Food Pantry of Murrieta \$3,000 the funding will be used for food purchases to be given to low–income families, and rental and utility assistance.
