Summary

Government Code §29550.1 allows counties to recover from the arrested person a criminal justice administration fee for administrative costs the Sheriff's Department incurred in conjunction with the arrest if the person arrested is convicted of any criminal offense related to the offense. The provision holds even if the conviction is not for the offense for which the person was originally arrested. The county notifies the Superior court regarding the fee and upon conviction the judge imposes an order of payment. The order is issued in the same manner as a civil judgement but is not enforceable by contempt. Furthermore, the court will, as a condition of probation, order the convicted person, based on ability to pay, to reimburse the county for the criminal justice fee. Fee calculation is based on the previous agenda item.

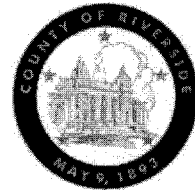


