Born on February 9, 1948 in Brooklyn, New York, Frank moved to San Bernardino, California in the 1950's. He attended St. Anne's and Aquinas High School before graduating from Pacific High School in 1965. Frank proudly served in the United States Army from 1967 to 1970. He earned his BA in Psychology from CSUSB, his MFCCT from Chapman University, and his PhD from USIU. He became a Clinical Psychologist in 1979.

Frank worked for San Bernardino County Probation Department. He co-owned, operated, and was the resident psychologist for a boy's ranch. He was also a partner in a shooting school and an SR Officer with LAPD. Frank helped select contestants for reality shows and worked on the set of two. He split his clinical psychology practice between Riverside and North Hollywood.

An avid runner, Frank competed in five LA Marathons and one Las Vegas Marathon. He also enjoyed sailing and driving, owning, racing, and working on cars. He loved his family, friends, dogs, orange blossoms, gardenias, oldies music, travelling, and playing the guitar.

Frank was a loving and devoted husband, father, grandfather, cousin, and friend. He was preceded in death by his parents and daughter Denise. He is survived by his wife Lynne, son Matthew (Kari), and grandchildren Allison and Jonathan.
