BACKGROUND: Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

- 1. Studio 395 Foundation, Inc. \$5,000 funding will be used to assist with improvements to the Lakeland Village Community Center. Studio 395 is the Operator of the county owned facility, and would like to complete some improvements to the Center that will help bring more programs and events to the facility for the residents of the First District. Improvements include: paint and repair and upgrade the art room patio cover to be a solid cover; maintenance cleaning of the dance room wood floors; creating a sound room in the MPR; and to assist with the purchase of sound and lighting equipment to enhance the capabilities of theatre events at the center.
- 2. Grove Community Church \$10,000 funding will be used to assist with improvements to the Moses Schaffer Community Center in Good Hope and the Charles Meigs Community Center in Mead Valley. Improvements for the Mead Valley Center include: grounds improvement to include a concrete bench with seating area and three entry-way planters. Improvements for the Good Hope Center include: improving current planters, building a retaining wall, and other landscaping improvements for overall beautification of the facility. The Grove Community Church is the Operator for both locations. These improvements to the Centers will help support the programs and services provided to First District residents.
