



**BACKGROUND:** Community Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

1. Cabazon Public Library will be used towards various programs and services that will serve the community including summer reading programs for the students.
2. Side by Side Humanitarian will use their support towards nutrition services for the less fortunate to provide meals throughout the community.
3. Table of Plenty will utilize their funding for various services that will be give back to the community such as food banks for the less fortunate throughout the year.
4. The Salvation Army a California Corporation will support various services that are available to our community and veterans such as social services, community food pantry and the Veterans Stand down event.
5. St. Christopher's Roman Catholic Church will be utilizing their funds to assist with various programs and services that will reach out to the community with providing food for the less fortunate and assisting the youth with summer programs.
6. Moreno Valley Unified School District will use their funding to continue to assist with programs for the students in the community throughout the school year.
7. Janet Goeske Foundation will use their support to promote health and wellness programs for older adults that are in need of assistance.
8. Riverside County Economic Development Agency will utilize their funding for the Fifth District Volunteer Appreciation Awards ceremony. The event will recognize outstanding community volunteers within the Fifth District. One individual from each city as well as the unincorporated communities will be selected to receive the volunteer award. The event will not only recognize these outstanding individuals, but it will also help inspire more community involvement and volunteerism throughout the County.
9. Riverside County Assessor-County Clerk-Recorder funding will be used to assist with marketing materials and supplies for the promotion of the County Archives to the public preservation of the County historical records, documents and objects.

10. Southern California Railway Museum funds will support museum operations and educational outreach programs for students and the community.
11. San Geronio Pass Historical Society funding will support operations and educational programs for students and the community.
12. Discovery Christian Church will utilize the funds to assist with various outreach programs such as, Feeding Children Everywhere, partnerships with Habitat for Humanity, homelessness care, senior care and Veterans assistance that provide for the less fortunate.
13. Perris Valley Filipino-American Association, Inc. funding will support the services and community outreach programs of the Filipino American Resource Center which provides awareness, education and mental health resources to those in need.
14. The Hispanic Association of Small Businesses donation will support the economic development and community programs that assist small businesses in the community.
15. HELP, Inc. will use their support for opportunities to serve the less fortunate with various programs and services such as their food bank and outreach events.
