BACKGROUND:

Summary

The Treasurer Tax Collector (TTC) desires to promote electronic payments county wide by providing County departments (including the County Fire Department), its agencies, and dependent districts (County Agencies) a streamlined and standardized process to arrange and maintain electronic payment options. Resolution No. 2018-128 (County Treasurer's Electronic Payment Processing Program) establishes a legal framework to do so.

Government Code Section 6159 authorizes a county and other public agencies to accept credit card, debit card, or electronic funds transfers for, among other things, the payment of any fee, charge, or tax due the public agency or for the payment of any services rendered by the public agency, to impose a fee for the use of a credit or debit card or electronic funds transfer not to exceed the costs incurred by the agency or its agent in providing for such payment and to pass-through reasonable issuer processing fees to the cardholder with the approval of the governing body having financial responsibility for the agency and to charge reasonable charges in the event that the credit card, debit card or electronic fund transfer is returned back to the county and other public agencies for any reason.

The County Treasurer's Electronic Payment Processing Program ("Program") provides County Agencies the option to accept credit card, debit card, or electronic funds transfers for, among other things, the payment of any services rendered or the payment of any fee, charge, or tax owed. It further authorizes each of the participating County Agencies who choose to do so, to impose a fee for the use of credit cards, debit cards, or electronic funds transfers not to exceed the costs incurred by it or its agent in providing for such payment. Also, the County Agencies will be able to charge a reasonable charge for the charge back or return, not to exceed the actual costs incurred by the county/agency, to recover the county/agency's processing and collection costs in the event a credit card, debit card, electronic funds transfer is returned without payment for any reason.

It is standard practice for a fee to be charged by the payment network (Visa, Master Card, American Express, etc.) for the use of credit cards, debit cards, or electronic funds transfers. This fee or charge is absorbed by either the user of the card or the entity receiving payments. This particular fee is generally referred to as a convenience fee, and there is an issue with

governmental agencies absorbing this fee which subsidizes private card users with public funds. So that county agencies do not absorb the convenience fee, the process allows them to pass the fee on to the private payer or card user.

The initial establishment of electronic payment options occurs infrequently, across a myriad of departments, and at various times. Establishment of this Program would enable a consolidation of any existing contracts and to provide for a master contract and single point of contact to administer electronic payments. Therefore, county agencies struggle in translating business needs to payment processor specs, reviewing and negotiating processor contracts, and building connections to back end systems and payment portals. There is no streamlined process that can currently be leveraged to assist county agencies with a more efficient and expedited means of establishing electronic payment options.

In today's society, electronic payments have become the preferred method of payment for various goods and services. Cash and check payments lack the speed, popularity, convenience and safety of electronic payments. Credit, debit and prepaid payment products make it easier for payers to access funds to make payments and are less cumbersome and labor intensive for the payment recipient. Electronic payments are typically conducted via the phone, on-line payment portals, or cashier terminals. County agencies accepting cards or other electric payments can reduce costs associated with: processing and reconciling payments; non-sufficient funds transactions; cash and check transportation expenses; as well as lowering cash handling risks and security concerns.

Notice of the public hearing was given pursuant to Government Code Section 6062a by publishing in newspapers of general circulation within the county.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

Any private residents or businesses who choose to use a credit card, debit card or electronic funds transfer to make payments to the County and its associated agencies and districts will pay the fee charged by the private card issuers of these private residents or businesses should the county or its agencies/districts set up to pass through such fees. Also, the private residents or businesses will still have the choice to submit payments by other means that would not be subject to these fees.

Additional Fiscal Information

The Treasurer-Tax Collector (TTC) is the largest County payment processor with an experienced team and the support of County Counsel and RCIT. The TTC directly processed over \$995 million in payments for FY 2016/2017, including \$535 million in ACH, \$38 million in Debit Card and \$85 million in Credit Card payments. The County Treasurer's Credit Card Processing program benefits the county by capitalizing on this experience, and allowing other

agencies to utilize an already existing streamlined and effective process for establishing electronic payment options.

Contract History and Price Reasonableness

By establishing and implementing the County Treasurer's Electronic Payment Processing Program, it will authorize the TTC to enter into contracts with issuers of credit cards, debit cards and electronic fund transfer agencies to enable the best pricing and contract terms for the County and its associated agencies and districts.

RESOLUTION NO. 2018-128

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE, ITS DEPARTMENTS, ITS AGENCIES, AND DEPENDENT DISTRICTS TO ACCEPT CREDIT CARD, DEBIT CARD, OR ELECTRONIC FUNDS TRANSFERS THROUGH ONE OR MORE PROGRAMS OFFERED BY OR THROUGH THE COUNTY TREASURER

WHEREAS, California Government Code Section 6159 authorizes a county and other public agencies to accept credit card, debit card, or electronic funds transfers for, among other things, the payment of any fee, charge, or tax due the public agency or for the payment of any services rendered by the public agency; and,

WHEREAS, California Government Code Section 6159 further authorizes a county and other public agencies to 1) impose a fee for the use of a credit or debit card or electronic funds transfer not to exceed the costs incurred by the county/agency or its agent in providing for such payment and to pass-through reasonable issuer processing fees to the cardholder with the approval of the governing body having financial responsibility for the county/agency; and 2) charge a reasonable charge for the charge back or return, not to exceed the actual costs incurred by the county/agency, to recover the county/agency's processing and collection costs in the event a credit card, debit card, electronic funds transfer is returned without payment for any reason; and,

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors is the governing body for the County of Riverside ("County") having financial responsibility for the County, its departments, its agencies, and dependent districts; and,

WHEREAS, the County Board of Supervisors has previously adopted Riverside County Ordinance No. 767 delegating to the County Treasurer the power to receive and keep funds of the County; and,

WHEREAS, the County Treasurer, pursuant this delegation, will be authorized to enter into one or more contracts with credit or debit card issuers and processors regarding the presentment and payment of credit cards, debit card drafts and electronic fund transfers for the benefit of the County, its

departments, its agencies, and dependent districts (hereinafter "the County Treasurer's Credit Card Processing Program"); and,

WHEREAS, this County Board of Supervisors desires to approve and authorize the County, its departments, its agencies, and dependent districts to utilize the County Treasurer's Credit Card Processing Program to accept credit card, debit card, or electronic funds transfers for, among other things, the payment of any fee, charge, or tax due to it or for the payment of any services rendered by it and to further authorize each of them to 1) impose a fee for the use of credit cards, debit cards, or electronic funds transfers not to exceed the costs incurred by it or its agent in providing for such payment and to pass-through reasonable issuer processing fees to the cardholder; and 2) charge a reasonable charge for the charge back or return, not to exceed the actual costs incurred by the County, to recover the County's processing and collection costs in the event a credit card, debit card, electronic funds transfer is returned without payment for any reason; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, DETERMINED, AND ORDERED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside, State of California, in regular session assembled on or after June 26, 2018, at 9:00 a.m. or soon thereafter, in the meeting room of the Board of Supervisors located on the 1st Floor of the County Administrative Center, 4080 Lemon Street, Riverside, California, upon closing of the public hearing, hereby adopts the following:

- 1. The County Treasurer's Credit Card Processing Program is hereby approved and any previous actions taken by the County Treasurer to establish and maintain the program are ratified, confirmed, and approved.
- 2. The County Treasurer is authorized to enter into one or more contracts with credit or debit card issuers and processors regarding the presentment and payment of credit cards, debit card drafts and electronic fund transfers for the benefit of the County, its departments, its agencies, and dependent districts to establish, implement, and maintain the County Treasurer's Credit Card Processing Program. Such contracts shall provide for the matters as presently described in California Government Code Section 6159, and as it may be amended from time to time, including but not limited to, the respective rights and duties of the county and the

card issuer, funds processor or draft purchaser regarding the processing and payment of credit and debit card drafts and electronic funds transfer requests.

- 3. Under and through the County Treasurer's Credit Card Processing Program, the County, its departments, its agencies, and dependent districts, are authorized to use the County Treasurer's Credit Card Processing Program to accept credit card, debit card, or electronic funds transfers for, among other things, the payment of any fee, charge, or tax due it or for the payment of any services rendered by it.
- 4. Under and through the County Treasurer's Credit Card Processing Program, the County, its departments, its agencies, and dependent districts, are authorized to impose a fee for the use of a credit or debit card or electronic funds transfer, not to exceed the costs incurred by it or its agent in providing for such payment; and the County, its departments, its agencies, and dependent districts, are authorized to pass-through reasonable issuer processing fees to the cardholder.
- 5. The County, its departments, its agencies, and dependent districts, are authorized to charge a reasonable charge for the charge back or return, not to exceed the actual costs incurred by the County, to recover the County's processing and collection costs in the event a credit card, debit card, electronic funds transfer is returned without payment for any reason.
- 6. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
