



BACKGROUND: Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organization:

1. Drop Zone Waterpark funding will be utilized for programs and service to provide approximately 150 low-income youth in the community with water safety instructions for swim lessons, which will promote a safe and healthy learning environment for swimmers to grow. Learn to Swim lessons are taught per Red Cross Curriculum, and emphasize skills to enhance comfort around water, water safety and stroke proficiency. All classes are taught by certified American Red Cross Water Safety Instructors.
