



BACKGROUND:

Summary

By Minute Order dated April 10, 2018 (Agenda Item 3.35), the County of Riverside (County) Board of Supervisors authorized the Clerk of the Board to advertise the McKinley Street Reconstruction Project between Indiana Avenue and Magnolia Avenue, in the Community of Home Gardens.

The work includes removal and replacement of the existing asphalt concrete pavement with new hot mix asphalt. Additional improvements will include reconstruction of curb ramps to comply with Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) requirements, reconstruction of damaged sections of existing curb, gutter, sidewalk, cross gutter and spandrels, relocation and replacement of roadside signs, replacement of traffic loops, placement of traffic stripes and pavement markings and other associated work.

On April 28, 2017, Senate Bill 1 (SB1) was passed to improve the state's aging transportation infrastructure, particularly roads and bridges. Because of this, the County is now able to improve the condition of roads in need of resurfacing or reconstruction and has included them in the County's Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). The McKinley Street resurfacing project is urgently needed to improve an aging roadway in a state of despair. Without SB1 urgently needed road repair projects would have been shelved until funding became available.

During the advertisement period, two addenda were issued to all registered plan holders as a supplement to the plans and specifications. Bidders were required to acknowledge and take into account all issued addenda on their contractor's Bid in order to be considered for award. Addendum 1 was issued to extend the bid receipt date, and addendum 2 was issued to clarify and modify the approved contract documents; both are attached herewith as Addendum No. 1 and 2.

The bid documents were prepared to include a Base Bid Schedule for County's proposed work and three Alternate Bid Schedules for utility companies. Utility companies did not accept the bid prices proposed by R.J. Noble Company. Therefore the alternate bid schedules are not selected

for award. Utility companies will perform the work with their own forces. The contract includes Base bid Schedule only.

The contractor, R.J. Noble Company is qualified to perform the work as outlined in the bid, has executed the contract, and has provided bonds and insurance documents which meet the requirements of the Contract.

County Project No. C6-0079

Impact on Residents and Businesses

The purpose of this project is to reconstruct a deteriorated segment of McKinley Street between Indiana Avenue and Magnolia Avenue to provide the public with a smooth paved roadway that will improve the safety and efficiency of vehicular traffic.

The work is scheduled to begin in summer of 2018, and will be phased to keep the road open during construction as much as possible and will take approximately one month to complete.

SUPPLEMENTAL:

Additional Fiscal Information

The contract is recommended for award to R.J. Noble Company, for the Base Bid total amount of \$761,933. The project is expected to be completed within the existing budget as shown on Attachment "A", which includes the contract award amount and other associated costs.

The project will be funded with Gas Tax /SB-1 funds for which the Transportation Department successfully completed. No General Funds will be used in this project.

Contract History and Price Reasonableness


Five bids were received ranging from \$774,732 to \$1,006,889. The basis for the selection of a contractor is the lowest responsive and responsible bid.

All received bids were responsive to the bidding requirements set forth for the project. The lowest responsible bid was submitted by R.J. Noble Company in the amount of \$774,733 which is \$292,267 (27%) below the Engineer's Estimate. The Base bid contract amount which is being awarded to R.J. Noble Company is \$299,067 (28%) below the Engineer's Estimate.

- A. The Contractor shall, on commencing operations, take all precautions required for public safety and shall observe all the provisions in the Specifications and the Special Provisions.
- B. All work done according to the Contract, prior to the issuance of the "Notice to Proceed", will be considered authorized work and will be paid for as provided in the contract.
- C. The Contractor shall not be entitled to any additional compensation or an extension of time for any delay, hindrance or interference caused by or attributable to commencement of work prior to the issuance of the "Notice to Proceed".

A. Amended Who Is An Insured

1. The following is added to the **Who Is An Insured** Provision in **Section II – Liability Coverage**:

The following are also "insureds":

- a. Any "employee" of yours is an "insured" while using a covered "auto" you don't own, hire or borrow for acts performed within the scope of employment by you.
- b. Anyone volunteering services to you is an "insured" while using a covered "auto" you don't own, hire or borrow to transport your clients or other persons in activities necessary to your business.
- c. Anyone else who furnishes an "auto" referenced in Paragraphs a. and b. above.
- d. Any person(s) or organization(s) where required by written contract or written agreement executed prior to any "accident" provided the "accident" arises out of operations contemplated by such contract or agreement.

2. The following is added to the **Other Insurance** Provision in the **Conditions** Section:

Coverage for any person(s) or organization(s) where required by written contract or written agreement executed prior to any "accident" will apply on a primary basis and any insurance maintained by the additional "insured" will apply on an excess basis. However, in no event will this coverage extend beyond the terms and conditions of the coverage form.

B. Amendment – Supplementary Payments

Paragraphs a.(2) and a.(4) of the **Coverage Extensions** Provision in **Section II – Liability Coverage** are replaced by the following:

- (2) Up to \$5,000 for the cost of bail bonds (including bonds for related traffic law violations) required because of an "accident" we cover. We do not have to furnish these bonds.

This exclusion does not apply to covered "autos" participating in a driver safety program event, such as, but not limited to, auto or truck rodeos and other auto or truck agility demonstrations.

E. Lease or Loan Gap Coverage

The following is added to the Coverage Provision of the Physical Damage Coverage Section:

Lease Or Loan Gap Coverage

In the event of a total "loss" to a covered "auto", we will pay any unpaid amount due on the lease or loan for a covered "auto", less:

- a. Any amount paid under the Physical Damage Coverage Section of the coverage form; and
- b. Any:
 - (1) Overdue lease or loan payments at the time of the "loss";
 - (2) Financial penalties imposed under a lease for excessive use, abnormal wear and tear or high mileage;
 - (3) Security deposits not returned by the lessor;
 - (4) Costs for extended warranties, credit life insurance, health, accident or disability insurance purchased with the loan or lease; and
 - (5) Carry-over balances from previous leases or loans.

F. Towing and Labor

The following is added to Paragraph A.2. of the Physical Damage Coverage Section:

We will pay up to \$75 for towing and labor costs incurred each time a covered "auto" of the private passenger type is disabled. However, the labor must be performed at the place of disablement.

G. Extended Glass Coverage

The following is added to Paragraph A.3.a. of the Physical Damage Coverage Section:

If glass must be replaced, the deductible will be \$100 or the deductible shown in the Declarations, whichever is less. If glass can be repaired and is actually repaired rather than replaced, the deductible will be waived. You have the option of having the glass repaired rather than replaced.

H. Hired Auto Physical Damage – Increased Loss of Use Expenses

The Loss Of Use Expenses Provision of the Physical Damage Coverage Section is replaced by the following:

Loss Of Use Expenses

For Hired Auto Physical Damage, we will pay expenses for which an "insured" becomes legally responsible to pay for loss of use of a vehicle rented or hired without a driver under a written rental contract or written rental agreement. We will pay for loss of use expenses if caused by:

- (1) Other than collision only if the Declarations indicate that Comprehensive Coverage is provided for any covered "auto";
- (2) Specified Causes Of Loss only if the Declarations indicate that Specified Causes Of Loss Coverage is provided for any covered "auto"; or
- (3) Collision only if the Declarations indicate that Collision Coverage is provided for any covered "auto".

However, the most we will pay for any expenses for loss of use is \$100 per day, to a maximum of \$3000.

I. Personal Effects Coverage

Personal Effects Coverage

- a. We will pay up to \$750 for "loss" to personal effects which are:
 - (1) Personal property owned by an "insured"; and

- (2) In or on a covered "auto".
- b. Subject to Paragraph a. above, the amount to be paid for "loss" to personal effects will be based on the lesser of:
 - (1) The reasonable cost to replace; or
 - (2) The actual cash value.

 - (3) Paintings, statuary and other works of art.
 - (4) Contraband or property in the course of illegal transportation or trade.
 - (5) Tapes, records, discs or other similar devices used with audio, visual or data electronic equipment.

Any coverage provided by this Provision is excess over any other insurance coverage available for the same "loss".

J. Tapes, Records and Discs Coverage

- 1. The Exclusion in Paragraph B.4.a. of Section III – Physical Damage Coverage in the Business Auto Coverage Form and the Exclusion in Paragraph B.2.c. of Section IV – Physical Damage Coverage in the Motor Carrier Coverage Form do not apply.
- 2. The following is added to Paragraph 1.a. Comprehensive Coverage under the Coverage Provision of the Physical Damage Coverage Section:

We will pay for "loss" to tapes, records, discs or other similar devices used with audio, visual or data electronic equipment. We will pay only if the tapes, records, discs or other similar audio, visual or data electronic devices:

- (a) Are the property of an "insured"; and
- (b) Are in a covered "auto" at the time of "loss".

The most we will pay for such "loss" to tapes, records, discs or other similar devices is \$500. The Physical Damage Coverage Deductible Provision does not apply to such "loss".

K. Airbag Coverage

The Exclusion in Paragraph B.3.a. of Section III – Physical Damage Coverage in the Business Auto Coverage Form and the Exclusion in Paragraph B.4.a. of Section IV – Physical Damage Coverage in the Motor Carrier Coverage Form do not apply to the accidental discharge of an airbag.

L. Two or More Deductibles

The following is added to the Deductible Provision of the Physical Damage Coverage Section:

If an accident is covered both by this policy or coverage form and by another policy or coverage form issued to you by us, the following applies for each covered "auto" on a per vehicle basis:

- 1. If the deductible on this policy or coverage form is the smaller (or smallest) deductible, it will be waived; or

Temporary Substitute Autos – Physical Damage

We will pay the owner for "loss" to the temporary substitute "auto" unless the "loss" results from fraudulent acts or omissions on your part. If we make any payment to the owner, we will obtain the owner's rights against any other party.

The deductible for the temporary substitute "auto" will be the same as the deductible for the covered "auto" it replaces.

O. Amended Duties In The Event Of Accident, Claim, Suit Or Loss

- (3) To the extent possible, the names and addresses of any injured persons and witnesses.




