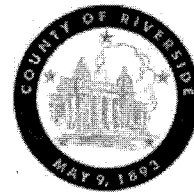

2. Find that the portion of the project for slurry seal treatment of Temescal Canyon Road from Leroy Road to 0.8 mile south is categorically exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines Section 15301 (c) - Existing Facilities; and



BACKGROUND:

Summary

Temescal Canyon Road Widening Projects

The Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) provides for the widening of two segments of Temescal Canyon Road from two to four travel lanes between Dawson Canyon Road and Dos Lagos Drive in the community of Temescal Valley as described below:

1. Dawson Canyon Road to 0.7 miles north
2. Dos Lagos Drive to Leroy Road

The work also includes applying a slurry seal and new pavement striping to the existing four-lane roadway between the above two segments.

Proposed improvements include the construction of one additional lane in each direction and an 8-foot bike lane each direction, along with a continuous center turn pocket. Traffic signals will be modified at Dawson Canyon Road and Dos Lagos Drive. Additional improvements include construction of a retaining wall, drainage improvements, utility relocations, sidewalk, curb and gutter, ADA compliant curb ramps, roadside signs, pavement markings, and reconstruction of driveways.

Once completed, the 1.3 miles of widening, will provide the public with a continuous four-lane road for 3.5 miles between Cajalco Road and the Temescal Canyon Road Interchange at I-15.

Temescal Canyon Road Drainage Improvement Project

The Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) provides for the Temescal Canyon Road Drainage Improvement Project at Coldwater Wash in the Community of Temescal Valley.

The Drainage Improvement is necessary due to storm water overtopping the road causing road closures because of the high water and debris removal. The proposed improvement includes the installation of two 6-foot wide by 2-foot high concrete drainage boxes under Temescal Canyon Road at Coldwater Creek, just north of Glen Ivy Road. The concrete boxes will accommodate the drainage from minor storms and reduce the frequency of road closures. In addition to the concrete boxes, concrete headwalls and guardrail will be constructed on both sides of the road.

The street widening and drainage projects are being combined to bid as one project in order to gain efficiencies by eliminating multiple bidding and administrative procedures, and to receive more favorable bids associated with larger bid quantities.

The submitted plans and specifications have been approved as to form by County Counsel.

Alternate Bid Schedule D: TVWD - Water Service Transfer

Alternate Bid Schedule E: Elsinore Valley Municipal Water District (EVMWD) - Utility Relocations

Alternate Bid Schedule F: Santa Ana Watershed Project Authority (SAWPA) - Utility Relocations

Relocation of utilities owned by the City of Corona, TVWD, EVMWD and SAWPA, respectively, are included in the bid package as alternate bids schedules. If the City of Corona, TVWD, EVMWD and SAWPA approve the award of their respective alternate bid schedules, as bid by the apparent low bidder, the costs for the work will be funded by the utility owners through a reimbursement agreement, which will be submitted to the Board of Supervisors for approval prior to or concurrent with the award of the construction contract.

The Transportation Department will select the contractor based upon the lowest responsive and responsible bid of the sum of all bid schedules.

Environmental Findings

Temescal Canyon Road Widening Projects

At its meeting on November 14, 2017 (Item 3.24), the Riverside County Board of Supervisors adopted the Final Initial Studies with Mitigated Negative Declarations and Mitigation Monitoring and Reporting Programs for the Temescal Canyon Road Widening Projects - Dawson Canyon Segment and Dos Lagos Segment based on the conclusion that the projects will not have a significant effect on the environment. The approval of the plans and specifications and authorization to advertise for bids is an implementing action in furtherance of the projects, and no further documentation is required under CEQA.

Slurry Seal Treatment - Temescal Canyon Road from Leroy Road to 0.8 Mile South

CEQA Guidelines Section 15301(c) describes the maintenance, repair and minor alteration of existing public facilities, with negligible or no expansion of an existing facility, to be considered as a categorical exemption under CEQA. This portion of the project for slurry seal treatment of Temescal Canyon Road from Leroy Road to 0.8 mile south qualifies under this exemption since it is a repair and maintenance activity taking place on existing County roads.

Coldwater Canyon Wash Box Culvert Project

At its meeting on March 1, 2016 (Item 3-34), the Riverside County Board of Supervisors found the Temescal Canyon Road Drainage Improvement Project at Coldwater Creek categorically exempt from CEQA pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines Section 15301(c) (existing facilities). The approval of the plans and specification and authorization to advertise for bids is an implementing action in furtherance of the projects, and no further documentation is required under CEQA.

Impact on Citizens and Businesses

Construction activities will maintain one lane of travel in each direction and will strive to minimize impacts during the morning peak hour commute. The proposed improvements will reduce congestion, increase safety, reduce vehicle emissions, improve access for emergency service responders, and improve the quality of life for residents and commuters along the Temescal Valley corridor.

Full road closure is required for the installation of the two reinforced concrete boxes under the road at Coldwater Creek. The public will be notified well in advance of the full closure of Temescal Canyon Road between Glen Ivy Road and Trilogy Parkway. Advanced publicity will include community meetings, notices to homeowner groups, newspaper ads, and direct contact with local companies with trucking operations.

The Widening Projects work is scheduled to begin in the Fall of 2018 and the Drainage Improvement Project will begin in the Summer of 2019. The projects will take approximately ten months to complete.

SUPPLEMENTAL:

Additional Fiscal Information

The construction contract is estimated to cost approximately \$14,077,701 and will be funded through local Measure A Regional Arterial (MARA) funds, State Senate Bill 1 Local Partnership Program (SB1 LPP) funds, and DIF AP6 Major Improvements Funds - Temescal Canyon Area.

On April 28, 2017, Senate Bill 1 (SB1) was passed to improve the state's aging infrastructure, particularly roads and bridges. SB1 included a Local Partnership Program (LPP) in which local agencies could compete. The intent of the LPP program is to reward agencies that have voter approved taxes or fees solely dedicated to transportation improvements. The California Transportation Commission approved the allocation of \$7.3 million of LPP funds for the Temescal Canyon Improvement Projects. Without SB1 this urgently needed capacity increasing project would have been shelved until funding became available.



There are no General Funds used in this project.



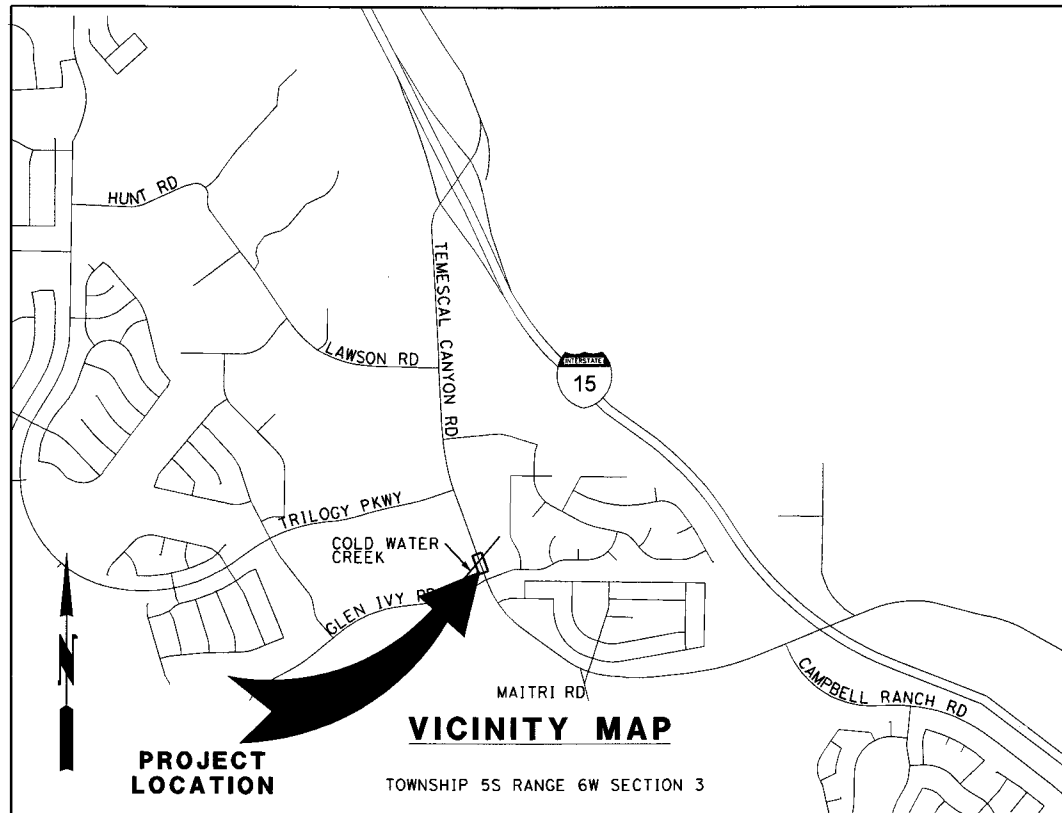
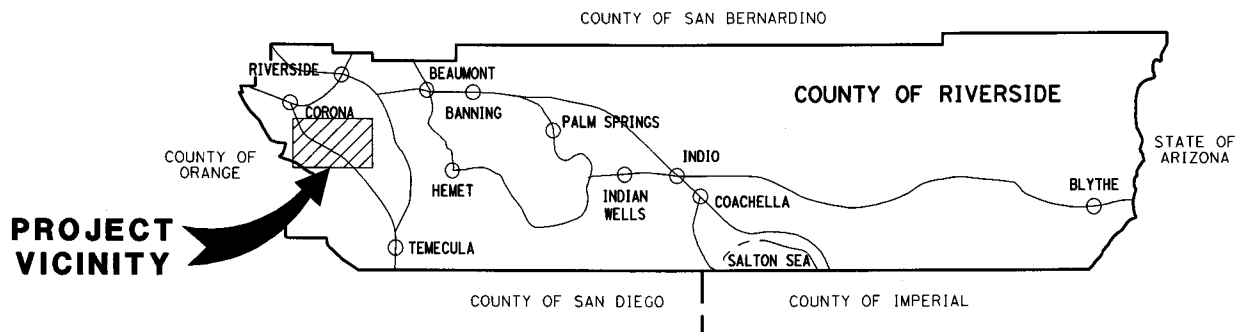


VICINITY MAP

SUPERVISORIAL DISTRICT: First Supervisorial District

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The County of Riverside Transportation Department is proposing to slurry seal¹ Temescal Canyon Road from 0.7 Miles North of Dawson Canyon Road to Leroy Road. Additional work will include replacement of pavement markings, striping bike lanes along the parking shoulders, and the addition of roadside signage. No additional right-of-way will be required to construct the proposed improvements, as the Project will be completed within the existing footprint of the roadway. The road profile will not be raised.

ENVIRONMENTAL ANALYSIS:

Because the Project consists of operation, maintenance and repair of an existing public facility, and there is no expansion of an existing roadway; this Project qualifies for a Class 1 Categorical Exemption under Section 15301 (c) of the CEQA Guidelines. Furthermore, for public safety, existing public facilities (e.g. street lights, fire hydrants) will be protected in place and the slurry seal and micro-surfacing processes of the facility will consist of maintenance and repair without expansion of highway capacity. Roadway striping and signage installation will be included to address safety of residential, pedestrian, and bike cyclists.


CEQA Finding:

The Transportation Department staff conducted a review of the project and determined that the project qualifies for a Class 1 Categorical Exemption under Section 15301 (c) of the CEQA Guidelines, Article 19 commencing with Section 15300. In accordance with Section 15301 (c), Class 1 projects consist of the operation, repair and maintenance of existing public facilities, such

¹ A slurry seal is the application of a mixture of water, asphalt emulsion, aggregate (very small crushed rock), and additives to an existing asphalt pavement surface. The placement of this mixture on existing pavement is the "seal" as it is intended to seal the pavement surface. Slurry seal is applied in order to help preserve and protect the underlying pavement structure and provide a new driving surface.

as highways, streets, sidewalks, gutters, bicycle and pedestrian trails and similar facilities.
