BACKGROUND:

Riverside County Workforce Development Board (WDB) is a private sector led policy and oversight body that supports economic expansion and the development of the regional workforce. The WDB is governed by the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act of 2014 (WIOA) which mandates that 50% of the WDB's members must come from the business community. In addition, WDBs are required to have representation from universities or community colleges and other training providers, as well as economic development and workforce program leaders. This ensures that federal funds for workforce development activities are expended on training and career coaching that meets the needs of the business community. Pursuant to WIOA, the Board of Supervisors, led by the Board Chairman who serves as the Chief Local Elected Official (CLEO), is responsible for appointing the WDB members for two year terms.

Mr. Juan M. De Lara, Sr., is a Risk Manager at Federated Insurance and currently serves as Vice-Chair for the WDB. Mr. De Lara previously served as Mayor of the City

of Coachella, Coachella City Council Member, and on city's the Planning Commission. Mr. De Lara has been a strong supporter and active member of the WDB and continues to be involved in his community. He has been instrumental in connecting the WDB with local industry businesses. Mr. De Lara is part of several boards and organization in the community and his participation and unique insight in the region he represents has brought workforce development services to the forefront in the Coachella Valley.

Mr. Juan M. De Lara, Sr., has expressed interest in being reappointed as a Private Sector Representative for the WDB in District Four. If reappointed he will serve a two year term commencing July 31, 2018 and expiring July 31, 2020.
