

**BACKGROUND:**

**Summary**

As a requirement of the Federally Qualified Health Center (FQHC) designation, the County must have a Community Health Center Board that is authorized by County Ordinance. There are thirteen (13) to twenty-five (25) positions on the Board; the majority must consist of users of services at the Community Family Care Centers. Board members must also be broadly representative of the characteristics of the population served. Joe Zamora has been reviewed and accepted by the Community Health Center Board.

An active FQHC Board is an important element of maintaining high quality care at the county's clinics.
