



**BACKGROUND:** Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

1. Smiles for Seniors Foundation (\$1,500.00) - the funding will support the Low-Income Senior Emergency Assistance Program, which provides low-income seniors with access to basic necessities such as food, housing and utility assistance, minor home and auto repairs, medications and medical equipment, and other valuable resources and referrals.
  
2. Hospice of the Valleys (\$2,500.00) - the funding will support "A Day of Wine & Chocolate," a fundraiser that helps the organization pay for the direct cost of hospice care for senior citizens and people who experience severe disabilities.
  
3. The Debbie Chisholm Memorial Foundation (\$2,500.00) - the funding will support the 7th annual "Cops 4 Kids with Cancer," a fundraiser that provides a complete holiday to families in Riverside County that are seriously ill and going through treatment.
  
4. Valley Resource Center (\$2,000.00) - the funding will support the Adopt-a-Troop Military Care Package Program, which sends snacks and hygiene items to troops who are deployed and will likely return to Riverside County.
