



**BACKGROUND:** Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

1. Murrieta Chamber of Commerce (\$1,000.00) - the funding will provide for the operating costs and logistics of the Murrieta State of the City event.
  
2. Temecula United Methodist MONKS (\$5,000.00) - the funding will support the annual fundraiser which provides funds to the St. Vincent de Paul Temecula Food Pantry so that the pantry can provide food, clothing, rent assistance, gas assistance, and baby items to low-income and homeless individuals.
  
3. Young Men's Christian Association of Orange County (\$3,500.00) - the funding will support the Murrieta Family YMCA Financial Assistance Program, which provides financial assistance to low-income clients in need of Y programs at the Murrieta Family YMCA.
