BACKGROUND:

Summary

The Sheriff's Department initiated a request for both RPDC, located at 4000 Orange Street in Riverside, and the CBDC, located at 30755-B Auld Road in Murrieta; to replace the flooring within the control rooms. RPDC opened its doors in September 1989; and CBDC opened its doors in September 1992. After several years of housing inmates, the control rooms flooring within both facilities have long outlived their life. The flooring for the central control room at CBDC needs to be replaced, for a total of one control room. In addition, at RPDC, the flooring for the central control room and the housing unit control rooms on each floor need to be replaced as well, for a total of ten control rooms at RPDC. The Sheriff's Department has determined they need to be replaced and modernized.

Pursuant to CEQA, the RPDC and CBDC Control Rooms Flooring project was reviewed and determined to be categorically exempt under State CEQA Guidelines Sections 15301 Existing Facilities Exemption; Section 15302 Replacement or Reconstruction; and Section 15061(b)(3), General Rule or "Common Sense" Exemption. With certainty, there is no possibility that the

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activity in question may have a significant effect on the environment because it merely involves the replacement of flooring within the control rooms at RPDC and CBDC. The improvements will not alter the overall function of the facilities. The interior improvements will not expand the capacity or increase the intensity of the existing services provided at the RPDC and CBDC. No direct or indirect impacts would occur. A Notice of Exemption will be filed by EDA staff with the County Clerk within five days of Board approval.

EDA recommends the Board approve the RPDC and CBDC Control Rooms Flooring project and the project budget of \$237,050. EDA will pursue the JOC project delivery method to complete the project at a fast turnaround time.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

The flooring replacement to the RPDC and CBDC facilities will enhance the safety and the security of staff. The Project will not cause a disruption to everyday duties for Sheriffs staff and the public.
