

BACKGROUND:

Summary

By Minute Order dated April 24, 2018 (Agenda Item 3.45), the County of Riverside (County) Board of Supervisors authorized the Clerk of the Board to advertise for reconstruction of the Wood Road and Parsons Road Reconstruction Projects, in the Community of Glen Valley.

Roadway reconstruction is needed due to deteriorated pavement conditions. The proposed reconstruction consists of grinding the existing pavement, re-grading the surface and the placement of new asphalt concrete pavement. The existing pavement on Wood Road currently ranges between 36' and 40' wide. The project proposes to reconstruct the existing roadway and widen the pavement between Dallas Avenue and Granite Avenue to provide a uniform 40' wide paved roadway throughout the project limits. The widened roadway will accommodate two 12' lanes and 8' wide paved shoulders. The Wood Road project will also include the construction of ADA compliant curb ramps at Markham Street.

Slurry Seal Treatment (Microsurfacing) will be applied to Wood Road from Cajalco Road to Markham Street, approximately 1.5 miles. The slurry seal treatment is provided as preventative maintenance to extend the life of the pavement and postpone more costly pavement rehabilitation. The slurry seal treatment seals small cracks, restores lost flexibility to the pavement surface and helps preserve the pavement structure.

The existing pavement on Parsons Road currently ranges between 22' and 24' wide. The project proposes to reconstruct the existing roadway and widen one to two feet on each side of the roadway to provide a uniform 26' wide paved roadway throughout the project limits. The widened roadway would accommodate two 12' lanes and 1' wide paved shoulders. Parsons Road will also include the construction of three bus turnouts so buses can stop without impacting through traffic.

Additional improvements on both projects include driveway tie-ins, upgrading signage, and the replacement of striping, thermoplastic pavement markings, and other associated work.

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On April 28, 2017, Senate Bill 1 (SB1) was passed to improve the state's aging transportation infrastructure, particularly roads and bridges. Because of this, the County is now able to improve the condition of roads in need of resurfacing or reconstruction and has included them in the County Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). The Wood Road and Parsons Road reconstruction projects are urgently needed to improve aging roads in a state of disrepair. Without SB1 this needed road repair project would have been shelved until funding became available.

During the advertisement period, one addendum was issued to all registered plan holders as a supplement to the plans and specifications, to clarify and modify the approved contract documents. Bidders were required to acknowledge and take the issued addendum into account on their Contractor's Bid in order to be considered for award. The addendum is attached and designated as Addendum No. 1.

The County of Riverside Transportation Department (Transportation Department) recommends award of the following schedules of work in the Contract amount of \$1,728,708:

- Base Bid Schedule 1: Wood Road Reconstruction Project
- Base Bid Schedule 2: Parsons Road Reconstruction Project
- Alternate Bid Schedule 4: Slurry Seal (Microsurfacing), Wood Road, between Cajalco Road and Markham Avenue
- Alternate Bid Schedule 5: Parsons Road Reconstruction Project - Utility adjustments to grade (Western Municipal Water District)

The bid documents were prepared to include two Base Bid Schedules and one Alternate Bid Schedule for County's proposed work, and four additional Alternate Bid Schedules for utility companies. Utility companies did not accept the bid prices proposed by All American Asphalt for Alternate Bid Schedules No. 1, 2, and No. 3 for the utilities adjustments work on Wood Road. For these three alternate bid schedules, utility companies will perform the work with their own forces. Western Municipal Water District has concurred with the bid prices for Alternate Bid Schedule No. 5, as bid by All American Asphalt for adjustments on Parsons Road.

The Contractor is qualified to perform the work as outlined in the bid, has executed the contract, and has provided bonds and insurance documents, which meet the requirements of the Contract.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

The purpose of this project is to rehabilitate deteriorated segments of Wood Road and Parsons Road both from Markham Street to Mariposa Avenue to provide the public with a smooth paved roadway that will improve the safety and efficiency of vehicular traffic. The slurry seal treatment

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on Wood Road between Cajalco Road and Markham Street will extend the life of the pavement thereby reducing the need for more extensive types of resurfacing that can be up to ten times more costly.

The work is scheduled to begin in summer of 2018, and will be phased to keep the road open during construction as much as possible and will take approximately two months to complete.

SUPPLEMENTAL:

Additional Fiscal Information

The contract is recommended to be awarded to All American Asphalt for the total amount of \$1,728,708. The project will be funded with Gas Tax/SB-1 funds and with Western Municipal Water District funds. There are no General Funds used in this project.

The Wood Road project and the Parsons Road project is expected to finish within the proposed budget as shown on Attachment "A", which includes the contract award amount and other associated costs.


Contract History and Price Reasonableness

Three bids were received ranging from \$1,735,273 to \$1,849,642. The basis for the selection of a contractor is the lowest responsive and responsible bid.


All received bids were responsive to the bidding requirements set forth for the project. The lowest responsible bid was submitted by All American Asphalt in the amount of \$1,735,273 which is \$510,140 (23%) below the Engineer's Estimate.

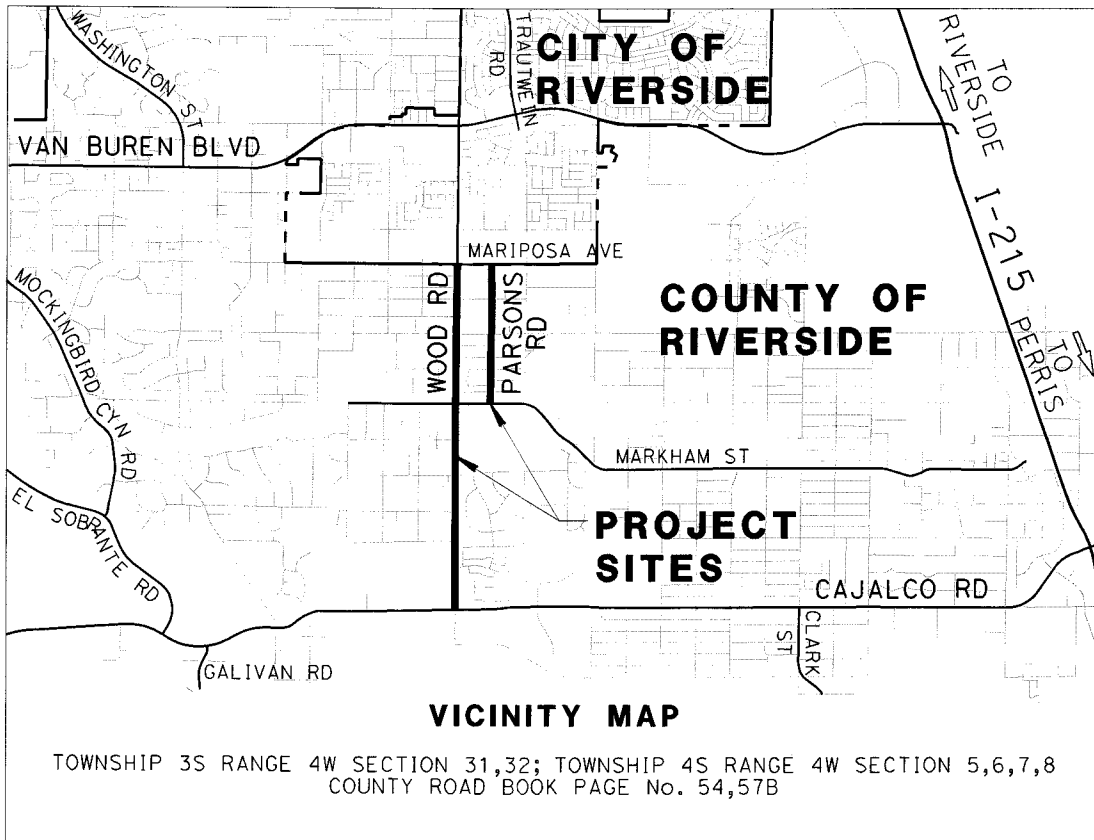
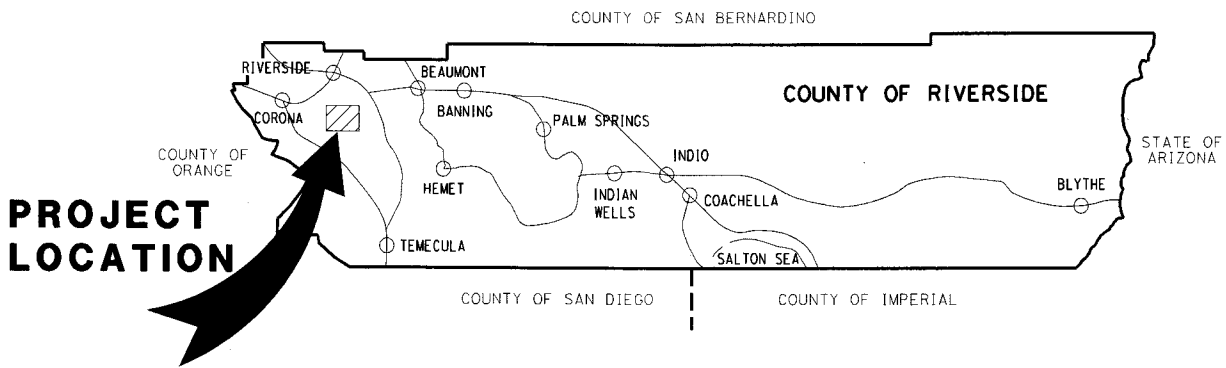

The Contractor shall cold plane the asphalt concrete pavement to a depth as shown on the approved plans or as directed by the Engineer.

The cold plane machine shall have a cutting head of at least 72 inches in width and shall be operated so as to not produce fumes or smoke.

Construction

The depth, width and shape of the cut shall be as indicated on the plan or as directed by the Engineer. The final cut shall result in a uniform surface conforming to the typical cross sections. The outside lines of the planned area shall be neat and uniform. The road surfacing to remain in place shall not be damaged in any way.

The material planed from the roadway surface, including material deposited in existing gutters or on the adjacent traveled way, shall be immediately removed from the site of the work and disposed of outside the job site. The removal crew shall follow within 50 feet of the planer, unless otherwise directed by the Engineer.

Nothing in these Special Provisions shall relieve the Contractor from his responsibilities as provided in Section 7-1.04, "Public Safety" of the Standard Specifications.

Removing of AC by milling may damage the base, if pavement base is damaged during milling process, you must re-compact or reconstruct the damaged portion of roadway as directed by Engineer. If reconstruction is required replace the sub base layer with 0.60' of aggregate base and re-compact it.

Replace Section 39-3.04D, Payment, with:

Payment

Cold Planing Asphalt Concrete Pavement will be paid for at the square yard bid price and shall include full compensation for providing all labor, tools, equipment, disposing of the grindings, and incidentals, sawcutting as shown on the plans, as directed by the Engineer, and no additional compensation will be allowed.

Payment for removal of pavement markers, thermoplastic traffic stripe, painted traffic stripe, and pavement marking within the area of cold planing is included in the payment for cold plane asphalt concrete pavement.

Payment for asphalt concrete dike removal as shown on the plans and as directed by the Engineer will be considered as included in the contract price paid per square yard for Cold Plane Asphalt Concrete Pavement, and for Grinding Asphalt Concrete in Place and no additional compensation will be allowed therefor.
