BACKGROUND:

Summary

By Minute Order dated April 10, 2018 (Agenda Item 3.37), the County of Riverside (County) Board of Supervisors authorized the Clerk of the Board to advertise the Grand Avenue Resurfacing Project from Machado Street to Plumas Street, in the Community of West Elsinore.

The work includes removal and replacement of the existing asphalt concrete pavement with new hot mix asphalt. Additional improvements will include reconstruction of curb ramps to comply with Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) requirements, installation of roadside signs, placement of traffic stripes and pavement markings, and other associated work.

On April 28, 2017, Senate Bill 1 (SB1) was passed to improve the state's aging transportation infrastructure, particularly roads and bridges. Because of this, the County is now able to improve the condition of roads in need of resurfacing or reconstruction and has included them in the County's Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). The Grand Avenue project is urgently needed to improve this aging road in a state of disrepair. Without SB1 urgently needed road repair projects would have been shelved until funding became available.

During the advertisement period, one addendum was issued to extend the bid receipt date and bidders were required to acknowledge and take into account all issued addenda on their contractor's Bid in order to be considered for award.

The bid documents were prepared to include a Base Bid Schedule for County's proposed work and two Alternate Bid Schedules for utility companies. Utility companies have concurred with the bid prices proposed by Frank and Son Paving, Inc. The reimbursement agreements between County and utility companies have been executed. The contract includes the following bid schedules:

Base Bid Sch. Grand Avenue pavement resurfacing and associated work
Alternate Bid Sch. 1: Manhole Adjustment for Elsinore Valley Municipal Water District
(EVMWD)

Alternate Bid Sch. 2: Manhole Adjustment for Frontier Communications

The contractor, Frank and Son Paving, Inc. is qualified to perform the work as outlined in the bid, has executed the contract, and has provided bonds and insurance documents which meet the requirements of the Contract.

County Project No. C8-0052

Impact on Residents and Businesses

The purpose of this project is to resurface the deteriorated segment of Grand Avenue between Machado Street and Plumas Street to provide the public with a smooth paved roadway that will improve the safety and efficiency of vehicular traffic.

The work is scheduled to begin in summer of 2018, and will be phased to keep the road open during construction as much as possible and will take approximately two months to complete.

SUPPLEMENTAL:

<u>Additional Fiscal Information</u>

The contract is recommended to be awarded to Frank and Son Paving, Inc. for a total amount of \$351,515. The project will be funded by Gas Tax /SB-1, EVMWD and Frontier Communications. There are no General Funds used in this project.

The proposed budget as shown on Attachment "A" includes the contract award amount and other associated costs.

Contract History and Price Reasonableness

Six bids were received ranging from \$351,515 to \$529,925. The basis for the selection of a contractor is the lowest responsive and responsible bid.

All received bids were responsive to the bidding requirements set forth for the project. The lowest responsible bid was submitted by Frank and Son Paving, Inc. in the amount of \$351,515 which is \$70,035 (16%) below the Engineer's Estimate.



Other words and phrases that are not defined under this Coverage Part but defined in the "controlling underlying insurance" will have the meaning described in the policy of "controlling underlying insurance".

The insurance provided under this Coverage Part will follow the same provisions, exclusions and limitations that are contained in the applicable "controlling underlying insurance", unless otherwise directed by this insurance. To the extent such provisions differ or conflict, the provisions of this Coverage Part will apply. However, the coverage provided under this Coverage Part will not be broader than that provided by the applicable "controlling underlying insurance".

There may be more than one "controlling underlying insurance" listed in the Declarations and provisions in those policies conflict, and which are not superseded by the provisions of this Coverage Part. In such a case, the provisions, exclusions and limitations of the "controlling underlying insurance" applicable to the particular "event" for which a claim is made or suit is brought will apply.

This endorsement modifies insurance provided by the following:

#### **BUSINESS AUTO COVERAGE FORM**

With respect to coverage provided by this endorsement, the provisions of the COVERAGE FORM apply unless modified by the endorsement.

- A. Newly Acquired or Formed
  Organizations, Employee Hired Car
  Liability and Blanket Additional Insured
  Status for Certain Entities.
  - Item 1. Who is an Insured of Paragraph A. Coverage under SECTION II COVERED AUTOS LIABILITY COVERAGE is amended to add:
  - d. Any organization you newly acquire or form, other than a partnership, joint venture or limited liability company, and over which you maintain ownership of a majority interest (greater than 50%), will qualify as a Named Insured; however,
    - coverage under this provision is afforded only until the 180th day after you acquire or form the organization or the end of the policy period, whichever is earlier;
    - (2) coverage does not apply to "bodily injury", "property damage" or "covered pollution cost or expense" that results from an "accident" which occurred before you acquired or formed the organization; and
    - (3) coverage does not apply if there is other similar insurance available to that organization, or if similar insurance would have been available but for its termination or the exhaustion of its limits of insurance.

  - (2) You purchase a replacement "auto".
  - (3) Repairs to your covered "auto" have been completed by the repair facility and they determine the covered "auto" is road-worthy.
  - (4) You reach the 30 day maximum coverage.



 Item 4. Coverage Extensions, of Paragraph A. Coverage, under SECTION III. PHYSICAL DAMAGE COVERAGE, is amended to add:

We will pay any resulting rental reimbursement expenses incurred by you for a rental of an "auto" because of "loss" to a covered "auto" up to a maximum of \$100 per day, for a maximum of 30 days for the same physical damage "loss", subject to the following conditions:

- a. We will provide rental reimbursement incurred during the policy period beginning 24 hours after the "loss" and ending, regardless of the policy expiration, with the number of days reasonably required to repair or replace the covered "auto". If the "loss" is caused by theft, this number of days is the number of days it takes to locate the covered "auto" and return it to you or the number of days it takes for the claim to be settled, whichever comes first.
- **b.** Our payment is limited to necessary and actual expenses incurred.
- c. This coverage does not apply while there are spare or reserve "autos" available to you for your operations.
- d. If a "loss" results from the total theft of a covered "auto" of the private passenger type, we will pay under this coverage only that amount of your rental reimbursement expenses which is not already provided for under the Physical Damage Coverage Extension.
- J. "Personal Effects" Exclusion

Paragraph B. Exclusions under SECTION III – PHYSICAL DAMAGE COVERAGE, is amended to add:

#### "Personal Effects" Exclusion

We will not pay for "loss" to "personal effects" of any of the following:

- Accounts, bills, currency, deeds, evidence of debt, money, notes, securities or commercial paper or other documents of value.
- Bullion, gold, silver, platinum, or other precious alloys or metals; furs or fur garments; jewelry; watches; precious or semi-precious stones.
- Paintings, statuary and other works of art.

- d. Contraband or property in the course of illegal transportation or trade.
- e. "Loss" caused by theft, unless there is evidence of forced entry into the covered "auto" and a police report is filed.
- K. Accidental Airbag Discharge Coverage Item 3.a. of Paragraph B. Exclusions under SECTION III – PHYSICAL DAMAGE COVERAGE is amended to read:
  - a. Wear and tear, freezing, mechanical or electrical breakdown. The exclusion relating to mechanical break-down does not apply to the accidental discharge of an air bag.
- L. Loan or Lease Gap Coverage

Paragraph C. Limit Of Insurance under SECTION III – PHYSICAL DAMAGE COVERAGE is amended to add:

If a covered "auto" is owned or leased and if we provide Physical Damage Coverage on it, we will pay, in the event of a covered total "loss", any unpaid amount due on the lease or loan for a covered "auto", less:

- The amount paid under the Physical Damage Coverage Section of the policy; and
- b. Any:
  - Overdue lease or loan payments including penalties, interest or other charges resulting from overdue payments at the time of the "loss";
  - (2) Financial penalties imposed under a lease for excessive use, abnormal wear and tear or high mileage;
  - (3) Costs for extended warranties, Credit Life Insurance, Health, Accident or Disability Insurance purchased with the loan or lease;
  - (4) Security deposits not refunded by the lessor; and
  - (5) Carry-over balances from previous loans or leases



#### M. Aggregate Deductible

Regardless of the number of covered "autos" involved in the same "loss", only one deductible will apply to that "loss". If the deductible amounts vary by "autos", then only the highest applicable deductible will apply to that "loss".

#### N. Diminishing Deductible

Paragraph D. Deductible under SECTION III – PHYSICAL DAMAGE COVERAGE is amended to add:

Any deductible will be reduced by the percentage indicated below on the first "loss" reported during the corresponding policy period:

#### O. Knowledge of Loss and Notice To Us

- (4) A manager or member, if you are a limited liability company;
- (5) Your insurance manager; or
- (6) Your legal representative.

Item 5. Transfer Of Rights Of Recovery Against Others To Us of Paragraph A. Loss Conditions under SECTION IV – BUSINESS AUTO CONDITIONS is amended to read:

#### 5. Transfer of Rights of Recovery Against Others To Us

If any person or organization to or for whom we make payments under this Coverage Form has rights to recover damages from another, those rights are transferred to us. That person or organization must do everything necessary to secure our rights and must do nothing after an "accident" or "loss" to impair them. However, if the insured has waived those rights to recover through a written contract, we will waive any right to recovery we may have under this Coverage Form.

- b. For Hired Auto Physical Damage Coverage, the following are deemed to be covered "autos" you own:
  - (1) Any covered "auto" you lease, hire, rent or borrow; and



(2) Any covered "auto" hired or rented by your "employee" under a contract in that individual "employee's" name, with your permission, while performing duties related to the conduct of vour business.

However, any "auto" that is leased, hired, rented or borrowed with a driver is not a covered "auto".

#### S. Unintentional Failure To Disclose Hazards

9. Your failure to disclose all hazards existing as of the inception date of this policy shall not prejudice the coverage afforded by this policy, provided that such failure to disclose all hazards is not intentional. However, you must report such previously undisclosed hazards to us as soon as practicable after its discovery.

#### T. Additional Definition

SECTION V - DEFINITIONS is amended to add:

"Personal effects" means personal property owned by the "insured".

"Downtime loss" means actual loss of "business income" for the period of time that a covered "auto":

- 1. Is out of service for repair or replacement as a result of a covered physical damage "loss" and
- 2. Is in the custody of a repair facility if not a total "loss".

"Business Income" means:

- 1. Net Income (Net Profit or Loss before income taxes) that would have been earned or incurred; and
- Continuing normal operating expenses incurred, including payroll.
