**BACKGROUND:**

Riverside County Workforce Development Board (WDB) is a private sector led policy and oversight body that supports economic expansion and the development of the regional workforce. The WDB is governed by the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act of 2014 (WIOA) which mandates that 50% of the WDB's members must come from the business community. In addition, WDBs are required to have representation from universities or community colleges and other training providers, as well as economic development and workforce program leaders. This ensures that federal funds for workforce development activities are expended on training and career coaching that meets the needs of the business community. Pursuant to WIOA, the Board of Supervisors, led by the Board Chairman who serves as the Chief Local Elected Official (CLEO), is responsible for appointing the WDB members for two year terms.

Mr. Peter Hubbard is the Government Affairs Manager at American Medical Response has over twenty years of healthcare management experience. Mr. Hubbard is currently an active member of the WDB and Vice-Chair of the WDB's West Regional Committee. He plays a key role in providing guidance and expertise in the healthcare industry, one of Riverside County's targeted industry sectors, and keeping the Board abreast of the industry and its evolving needs.

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Mr. Hubbard has confirmed his interest in continuing to serve on the WDB as a Private Sector Representative for District One. If reappointed he will serve a two year term commencing August 28, 2018 and expiring August 28, 2020.
