BACKGROUND:

Riverside County Workforce Development Board (WDB) is a private sector led policy and oversight body that supports economic expansion and the development of the regional workforce. The WDB is governed by the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act of 2014 (WIOA) which mandates that 50% of the WDB's members must come from the business community. In addition, WDBs are required to have representation from Universities or community colleges and other training providers, as well as economic development and workforce program leaders. This ensures that federal funds for workforce development activities are expended on training and career coaching that meets the needs of the business community. Pursuant to WIOA, the Board of Supervisors, led by the Board Chairman who serves as the Chief Local Elected Official (CLEO), is responsible for appointing the WDB members for two year terms.

Mr. Chuck McDaniel is a Labor Representative of the International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers (IBEW) Local 440 and has served on the WDB as a labor representative for over a decade. He serves as a delegate to the North America's Building Trades Unions, the State Building & Construction Trades Council of California, the California State Association of Electrical Workers, and the California Labor Federation; he also serves on the Board of

Directors for United Way of the Desert. Because the WDB has identified construction as being an in-demand industry, Mr. McDaniel's membership brings great benefits to the WDB. His extensive experience in the trades brings insight to identifying and addressing current and future regional workforce needs in the industry and working with businesses, workforce development and the community.

Mr. Chuck McDaniel has confirmed his interest in continuing to serve on the WDB as a Labor Representative for All Districts. If reappointed he will serve a two year term commencing September 14, 2018 and expiring September 14, 2020.
