C.E.O. RECOMMENDATION: APPROVE

BACKGROUND:

Pursuant to action taken on November 26, 2013, (Item 3-8), the Board established the Cabazon Community Revitalization Act Infrastructure Fund into which is deposited 25 percent of the sales and use tax generated by the expansion area of the Desert Hills Factory Outlets development. Per the Board's direction, these proceeds are to be used exclusively for infrastructure and public safety needs in and around the Cabazon community. The Executive Office administers this fund.

Based on tentative plans expressed by TLMA during the budget preparation process to initiate preliminary work on transportation plans in the area, the Executive Office recommended appropriating \$1 million from this fund toward that effort. However, TLMA subsequently decided to defer initiation of that work until after this fiscal year. Consequently, the Executive Office recommends withdrawing that appropriation and committing the amount toward that work in future years. The Executive Office further recommends making further appropriations from this fund on a project-specific basis concurrent with project approval.

If the related sales tax revenues come in at the projected level of \$783,000 this fiscal year, the Executive Office projects the amount of committed fund balance will total approximately \$3.7 million by the end of this year.
