

BACKGROUND:

Summary

Riverside County Ordinance No. 533 provides for the administration of the Emergency Management Organization for the County of Riverside. The County Executive Officer serves as the Director of Emergency Services and is responsible for providing direction and control of the Riverside County Emergency Management Organization. Amending Ordinance No. 533 is necessary to reflect the changes in that organization and the County's Emergency Management Program.


Impact on Residents and Businesses

The purpose of Ordinance No. 533 is to provide for the coordination of disaster mitigation, preparation, response and recovery activities for the protection of persons and property within the County of Riverside. The amendment to the ordinance will improve flexibility and capacity for accomplishing these objectives.


Additional Fiscal Information

The initiation and implementation costs are in the FY2018/2019 budget and no budget adjustment is requested. The cost is estimated at approximately \$2,500 for 60 hours of staff preparation time that is covered in the approved EMD budget.

There are no additional administrative costs anticipated as the amendment to the ordinance would reconcile the ordinance, last updated by the Board of Supervisors on 6/22/10 (item 3.4), with the current Emergency Management Organization structure.
