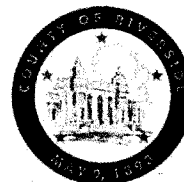



4. Approve the project's proposed budget as shown on Attachment A.



BACKGROUND:

Summary

By Minute Order dated May 22, 2018 (Agenda Item 3.37), the County of Riverside (County) Board of Supervisors authorized the Clerk of the Board to advertise for the resurfacing of Borel Road from Auld Road to Buck Road in the Community of French Valley, and the resurfacing of Rancho California Road from Monte De Oro to Buck Road in the Community of Rancho California.

The Borel Road work includes grinding and removal of the existing asphalt concrete (AC) pavement and overlay with new hot mix asphalt. Additional improvements will include construction of driveway approaches, reconstruction of AC dike, catch basin, overside drain, shoulder backing, installation of roadside signs, placement of traffic stripes and pavement markings, and other associated work.

The Rancho California Road work includes grinding and removal of the existing AC pavement and overlay with new hot mix asphalt. Additional improvements will include construction of cross-gutter and spandrel, AC driveways, reconstruction of AC dike, shoulder backing, installation of roadside signs, placement of traffic stripes and pavement markings, and other associated work.

On April 28, 2017, Senate Bill 1 (SB1) was passed to improve the state's aging transportation infrastructure, particularly roads and bridges. Because of this, the County is now able to improve the condition of roads in need of resurfacing or reconstruction and has included them in the County's Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). The Borel Road and Rancho California Road projects are urgently needed to improve aging roads in a state of disrepair. Without SB1, urgently needed road repair projects would have been shelved until funding became available.

During the advertisement period, one addendum was issued to all registered plan holders as a supplement to the plans and specifications. Bidders were required to acknowledge and take into account all issued addenda on their contractor's Bid in order to be considered for award. Addendum is attached and designated as Addendum No.1.

The bid documents were prepared to include a Base Bid Schedule for County's proposed work and two Alternate Bid Schedules for utility companies. One of the alternate bid schedules related to Metropolitan Water District (MWD) was removed by addendum 1. However the alternate bid schedule related to Eastern Municipal Water District (EMWD) remained on the bid proposal. EMWD did not concur with the bid prices proposed by All American Asphalt. Therefore their alternate bid schedule has also been removed from the contract. EMWD will do the utility adjustment work with their own forces. The contract includes the following bid schedules:

Base Bid Sch. 1	Borel Road pavement resurfacing and associated work.
Base Bid Sch. 2	Rancho California Road pavement resurfacing and associated work.

The contractor, All American Asphalt is qualified to perform the work as outlined in the bid, has executed the contract, and has provided bonds and insurance documents which meet the requirements of the Contract.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

The purpose of this project is to reconstruct deteriorated segments of Borel Road and Rancho California Road to provide the public with a smooth paved roadway with the goal of improving the safety and efficiency of vehicular traffic.

The work is scheduled to begin in the summer of 2018. The work will be phased to keep the roads open during construction as much as possible and will take approximately two months to complete.

SUPPLEMENTAL:

Additional Fiscal Information

The contract is recommended to be awarded to All American Asphalt for a total amount of \$2,137,395, and the project will be funded by Gas Tax /SB-1.

The proposed budgets as shown on Attachment "A" include the contract award amount and other associated costs.

There are no General Funds used in this project.

Contract History and Price Reasonableness

Five bids were received ranging from \$2,139,495 to \$2,403,643. The basis for the selection of a contractor is the lowest responsive and responsible bid.

All received bids were responsive to the bidding requirements set forth for the project. The lowest responsible bid was submitted by All American Asphalt in the amount of \$2,139,495 which is \$123,672 (5.5%) below the Engineer's Estimate. However the contract award amount is \$2,137,395 which is \$124,772 (5.5%) below the Engineer's Estimate.
