BACKGROUND:

1. The donation to Big Brothers Big Sisters of the Inland Empire will be used to fund their Road to Success: Building Resiliency and Academic Achievement Program, which matches qualified high school student leaders with at-risk elementary school youth providing one-to-one peer mentoring as well as emotional, academic and social support.
2. The donation to Food Runners Club will be used to help purchase a catering van so the organization can continue to teach high school youth how to prepare, cook and serve food which provides them with job and life skills. In addition, Food Runners Club provides catering services to other non-profits throughout Riverside County, which lets them benefit while the kids are learning real world skills.
3. The donation to the Riverside Educational Enrichment Foundation will be used to provide educational enrichment for students by funding classroom grants, student trips, scholarships and teacher grants.
4. The donation the Veterans of Foreign Wars Post 10267 will be used to complete facility improvements which includes painting both inside and out.
