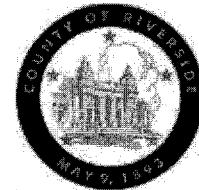





**BACKGROUND:**

1. The donation to the Uptown Kiwanis helps fund their annual fundraiser that provides about \$40,000 per year to needy families. Their programs benefit families from Riverside Unified School District and they take care of about 200 families at Thanksgiving and Christmas.
2. The donation to the Riverside University Health System Foundation will be used to sponsor their annual fundraising gala "Festival of Trees" which raises funds for needed equipment in the pediatric unit at the hospital.
3. The donation to Simple Acts of Care and Kindness will be used to sponsor their annual "World Kindness Youth Conference" which encourages kindness, respect, mindfulness, teamwork and other areas that discourage bullying. The conference is for 4<sup>th</sup> grade students in the Corona-Norco Unified School District.
4. The donation to the Reaching New Heights Foundation will be used at the annual At-Risk Veterans Stand Down which will be held on September 28<sup>th</sup> at the March Air Base National Guard Training Center. At-risk veterans can receive emergency food, gas or other gift cards to help them on their road to stability.
