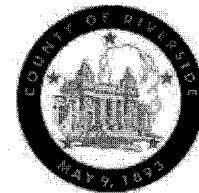



**BACKGROUND:**

1. The donation to the Corona-Norco Family YMCA will be used for their annual fundraising dinner, YMCA Kids Rock Free Program and their Youth in Government Program.
2. The donation to the Jurupa Valley High School Band and Color Guard will be used to help the students compete in championships, by providing vital equipment for the band and color guard.
3. The donation to the Riverside County Regional Park and Open-Space District will be used to fund a feasibility study for the Trujillo Adobe, one of the oldest surviving building remnants in Riverside County. The study will determine the economic viability of the Adobe for use as an interpretive, cultural and historic environment.
4. The donation to the Fox Riverside Theater Foundation will fund the Students at Broadway education and outreach program. Students are invited to a show, provided background and theater etiquette information and are able to interact with cast.
