BACKGROUND: Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

1. Valley Restart Shelter – \$2,500 the funding will be used for a fundraiser to support Valley Restart Shelter, a place and resource center for persons experiencing homelessness.
2. Boys and Girls Club of Southwest County - \$2,500 the funding will be utilized for the before and after school programs for youth in the Temecula and Murrieta areas.
3. Student of the Month Program Inc. - \$3,000 the funding will be used to recognize Student of the Month participants and for Student of the Month scholarships.
4. United Way of the Inland Valleys - \$2,500 the funding will be utilized to support the Girls Excelling in Mathematics with Success program at the middle school level in the Murrieta and Temecula areas.
