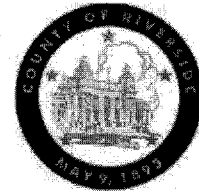



**BACKGROUND:** Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

1. Hemet San Jacinto Valley Chamber of Commerce- \$1,000 the funding will support the 2018 Hemet State of the City which educates local residents and business owners on the economic development of the City of Hemet.
2. Reaching New Heights Foundation - \$3,000 the funding will be utilized for 2018 Veterans Stand Down event which is a one stop event that connects veterans in need of assistance to VA services as well as non-profit organizations that help veterans and their families.
3. Assistance League of Temecula Valley - \$3,000 the funding will be used for Operation School Bell that provides new school appropriate clothing for economically disadvantaged K-12 school age children.
4. Golden Valley Music Society Inc. - \$1,500 the funding will used for 4<sup>th</sup> grade students in Murrieta School District to participate with local orchestra programs.
